The KING has been graciously pleased, on the advice of Canadian Ministers, to approve the award of the British Empire Medal (Military Division) to the undermentioned:—

Can/R.82276 Leading Aircraftman William Edward Billings, Royal Canadian Air Force.

ROYAL AIR FORCE.

The KING has been graciously pleased to approve the following awards in recognition of gallantry displayed in flying operations against the enemy:—

Distinguished Service Order.

Acting Wing Commander Alan Christopher DEERE, D.F.C. (40370).

This officer has displayed exceptional qualities of skill which have played a large part in the successes of formations he has led. His fearlessness, tenacity and unswerving devotion to duty have inspired all with whom he has flown. Wing Commander Deere has destroyed 18 enemy aircraft.

Acting Wing Commander James Edgar JOHNSON, D.F.C. (83267), Royal Air Force Volunteer Reserve.

This officer has led a wing on a large number of occasions and has displayed outstanding skill and gallantry. During an operation, one morning in May, 1943, his formation was heavily engaged by a large force of enemy fighters. In the ensuing combats 4 enemy aircraft were destroyed without loss. The same afternoon he took part in a similar sortie and 3 enemy fighters were destroyed, 1 of them by Wing Commander Johnson. The next day, this officer took part in another successful sortie. By his skilful and courageous leadership, Wing Commander Johnson contributed materially to the success achieved. He has destroyed at least 13 enemy aircraft.

Flying Officer Raymond John PHILLIPS (115940), Royal Air Force Volunteer Reserve, No. 114 Squadron.

In April, 1943, this officer was the navigator of the leading aircraft of a bomber formation detailed to attack enemy air fields. Whilst over the target area the formation was subjected to heavy anti-aircraft fire. Flying Officer Phillips sustained a wound in the foot, which was almost severed. Although in considerable pain he continued to direct the formation to the target which was successfully bombed before he collapsed. Flying Officer Phillips displayed great fortitude and outstanding devotion to duty, contributing in a large measure to the success of the operation. His exemplary conduct was in keeping with the highest traditions of the Royal Air Force.

Bar to Distinguished Flying Cross.

Acting Squadron Leader John Joseph LYNCH, D.F.C. (103470), No. 249 Squadron.

This officer is a skilful fighter, whose courageous example has inspired the squadron he commands. Squadron Leader Lynch has taken part in many sorties and has led his formations with great determination. He has destroyed 12 enemy aircraft.

Acting Squadron Leader Ernest Waite WOOTTEN, D.F.C. (42667), No. 118 Squadron.

This officer, who has taken part in very many sorties, has led the squadron and, occasionally the wing, with great skill and dash. His fine example and outstanding devotion to duty have been inspiring.

Flight Lieutenant Richard Alfred NEWBERRY, D.F.C. (60104) Royal Air Force Volunteer Reserve, No. 118 Squadron.

This officer has completed a very large number of sorties and has rendered excellent service. On one occasion he attacked an E-boat, setting it on fire; he has also destroyed an enemy aircraft. Flight Lieutenant Newberry is a most efficient flight commander, whose example of courage and determination has been worthy of high praise.

Distinguished Flying Cross.

Wing Commander Wilfrid Ewart OULTON (26209), No. 58 Squadron.

Recently, this officer was the captain of an aircraft which attacked a U-boat. Later in the day another submarine was observed on the surface of the water. In the face of accurate anti-aircraft fire from the vessel, Wing Commander Oulton pressed home a vigorous attack. During a patrol some days later, he executed a destructive attack on yet another U-boat. Wing Commander Oulton has displayed great keenness and efficiency.

Squadron Leader Foss Henry BOULTON (Can./C.1090), Royal Canadian Air Force, No. 416 (R.C.A.F.) Squadron.

This officer has taken part in a large number of sorties, including many low level attacks on targets in Northern France. He has invariably displayed great skill and courage and has destroyed at least 4 enemy aircraft.

Flight Lieutenant Anthony Gilbert Frederick OLDWORTH (89829), Royal Air Force Volunteer Reserve, No. 681 Squadron.

Flying Officer Charles Douglas PAILTHORPE (Aus.406091), Royal Australian Air Force, No. 681 Squadron.

In March, 1943, these officers undertook an operational flight and achieved outstanding success. They have completed much operational flying displaying great skill, courage and devotion to duty.

Acting Flight Lieutenant Robert Andrew BUCKHAM (Can./J.15426), Royal Canadian Air Force, No. 416 (R.C.A.F.) Squadron.

This officer has taken part in a large number of sorties and has proved himself to be a fine fighter

and a first class leader. He has destroyed 4 enemy aircraft and damaged 5 locomotives.

Acting Flight Lieutenant Harry Deane MACDONALD (Can./J.15467), Royal Canadian Air Force, No. 403 (R.C.A.F.) Squadron.

This officer, who has participated in a very large number of sorties, is an excellent flight commander. In addition to destroying 5 enemy aircraft, Flight Lieutenant Macdonald has damaged 3 locomotives and executed vigorous attacks on other targets. He has invariably displayed outstanding keenness.

Pilot Officer Ernest Victor DOMONE (137317) Royal Air Force Volunteer Reserve, No. 409 (R.C.A.F.) Squadron.

One night in April, 1943, this officer was a member of the crew of an aircraft engaged on an offensive operation. During the flight the aircraft was hit by anti-aircraft fire and Pilot Officer Domone was seriously wounded in the thigh. Despite intense pain and loss of blood, Pilot Officer Domone reassured his pilot and gave him a course for base. This officer displayed courage and fortitude of the highest order.

Distinguished Flying Cross.

Wing Commander Richard Valentine MCINTYRE (26143), No. 100 Squadron.

Distinguished Flying Medal.

Aus.411381 Flight Sergeant James Darcy William RENNO, Royal Australian Air Force, No. 100 Squadron.

One night in May, 1943, Wing Commander McIntyre and Flight Sergeant Renno were captain and wireless operator/air gunner of an aircraft detailed to attack Bochum. When nearing the target area the aircraft was hit by anti-aircraft fire. Two engines were put out of action, while other equipment was damaged. Despite this, Wing Commander McIntyre continued to the target and bombed it. Not until the task was accomplished did Flight Sergeant Renno inform his captain that he had been wounded in the stomach and thigh. Although the aircraft was difficult to control, Wing Commander McIntyre skilfully flew the aircraft back to this country on 2 engines and effected a crash-landing at an airfield. Despite his injuries, Flight Sergeant Renno worked his wireless apparatus on the return flight, obtaining bearings which were of great assistance. Both these members of aircraft crew displayed great courage and determination.

Distinguished Flying Cross.

Flying Officer Frank Edward LEWIS (Can/J 10317), Royal Canadian Air Force, No. 7 Squadron.

Distinguished Flying Medal.

544755 Sergeant Thomas Ingham BODDY, No. 7 Squadron.

In air operations, these members of aircraft crew have displayed exemplary conduct and gallantry worthy of the highest praise.

Conspicuous Gallantry Medal (flying).

1344057 Sergeant John Patrick McGARRY, No. 70 Squadron.

One night in April, 1943, this airman was the navigator of an aircraft detailed to attack an enemy landing ground. During the operation the aircraft was hit by anti-aircraft fire. The pilot was severely wounded, while Sergeant McGarry was wounded in the leg. Despite his injury, this airman helped to remove the wounded pilot from the cockpit and afterwards rendered efficient first aid. Meanwhile, another member of the crew took over the control and Sergeant McGarry, displaying great fortitude, continued his navigational duties. In addition, throughout the return flight, he tended his injured pilot. When base was reached the pilot took over the controls to attempt a landing. Sergeant McGarry was given permission to leave by parachute but elected to stay with his pilot and a successful crash-landing was made near the airfield. In perilous circumstances, Sergeant McGarry displayed courage, fortitude and coolness worthy of the highest praise.

1070296 Sergeant Thomas Parker PETRIE, No. 70 Squadron.

One night in April, 1943, this airman was the pilot and captain of an aircraft detailed to attack an enemy landing ground. In the run up the aircraft was hit by anti-aircraft fire but Sergeant Petrie held course and a stick of bombs was re-

leased. Almost immediately the aircraft was again hit which caused it to dive steeply. Sergeant Petrie was severely wounded, his foot being practically severed, while other members of the crew were slightly wounded. Despite his injuries, Sergeant Petrie skilfully regained control of his aircraft, circled and released the remaining bombs over the target area. Course having been set for home, the injured pilot was removed from his seat and given first aid, while another member of the crew kept the aircraft on its course to base. When the airfield was reached, Sergeant Petrie who, throughout the return flight, though in considerable pain and faint through loss of blood had remained in command as captain, gave the crew permission to leave by parachute. They elected to remain, however, confident in his ability to effect a landing. By strapping him in the pilot's seat and tying his uninjured foot to the rudder bar, Sergeant Petrie was able to take over the controls. When approaching land, at a height of 300 feet, the petrol supply ran out but a successful crash-landing was made. This gallant airman displayed great courage and fortitude in keeping with the highest traditions of the Royal Air Force.

Distinguished Flying Medal.

1322681 Sergeant Francis Cyril COMPTON, No. 10 Squadron.

One night in May, 1943, this airman was the rear gunner of an aircraft detailed to attack Duisburg. During the operation his aircraft was attacked and damaged by an enemy fighter. Sergeant Compton resolutely returned fire and, following an accurate burst, the enemy aircraft stalled and then fell towards the ground, disappearing out of sight through the clouds. Half-an-hour later, the bomber was again attacked by enemy fighters. In the ensuing action Sergeant Compton coolly and skilfully used his guns while giving his captain directions which enabled him to evade the attackers. The following night during an operation against Bochum his aircraft which had been damaged by anti-aircraft fire, was attacked by 2 enemy aircraft. Displaying great skill and determination, Sergeant Compton shot 1 of them down. Although his guns were rendered useless, he gave his captain a commentary which enabled him to evade the remaining fighter. On both occasions this airman displayed great courage and determination and contributed materially to the safe return of the aircraft.

Aus.408569 Sergeant Alexander Douglas FINLAYSON, Royal Australian Air Force, No. 199 Squadron.

One night in May, 1943, this airman was the rear gunner of an aircraft detailed to attack Dortmund. On the return flight, the aircraft was attacked by an enemy fighter. Sergeant Finlayson coolly withheld his fire until the attacker came into close range and then, with a well directed burst, shot the enemy aircraft down. His skill and vigilance have been an inspiring example.
