The KING has been graciously pleased to approve the following awards in recognition of gallantry displayed in flying operations against the enemy:—

Distinguished Service Order.

Acting Squadron Leader Peter John CUNDY, D.F.C. (43098), No. 224 Squadron.

Since being awarded the Distinguished Flying Cross this officer has been almost continuously engaged on operations. In February, 1943, during an anti-submarine patrol, he executed 2 attacks on U-boats. During a flight in July, 1943, Squadron Leader Cundy sighted a U-boat. In spite of heavy opposing fire from the vessel, which damaged his aircraft and disabled 1 engine, he pressed home 2 vigorous attacks, straddling the U-boat with his depth charges. Afterwards a large patch of oil appeared on the surface of the water. Squadron Leader Cundy is a skilful pilot whose leadership, courage and determination have been outstanding.

Flight Lieutenant Arthur John HODGKINSON, D.F.C. (45353), No. 23 Squadron (since missing).

This officer has completed much operational flying. Latterly, in the Middle East, he has bombed targets in Tunisia, Italy and Sicily and, during these operations, he has attacked numerous locomotives to good effect, while fires have been started in railway installations and sidings as a result of his determined work. In addition, Flight Lieutenant Hodgkinson has executed many sorties over enemy airfields during which he has destroyed 3 hostile aircraft and caused much disorganisation. His sterling work has contributed in a large measure to the successes of his squadron.

Bar to Distinguished Flying Cross.

Acting Wing Commander William James ALINGTON, D.F.C., A.F.C. (70006), Reserve of Air Force Officers, No. 264 Squadron.

This officer has displayed exceptional keenness and determination to inflict loss on the enemy. On 1 sortie, he damaged 7 locomotives. More recently, in June, 1943, he led a formation of light bombers on an operation which resulted in the destruction of 4 enemy aircraft on the ground, while much damage was caused to a hangar. In addition, a minesweeper was attacked and damaged. By his fearless and skilful leadership, Wing Commander Alington played a large part in the success of the sortie.

Flight Lieutenant John Alexander SPENCE, D.F.C. (Can/J.3995), Royal Canadian Air Force, No. 277 Squadron.

In June, 1943, this officer undertook a flight to search for a pilot who was adrift in his dinghy

in the English Channel. He succeeded in locating the dinghy some 2½ miles from the French coast. The sea was exceedingly rough but Flight Lieutenant Spence brought his aircraft down safely on to the water, then taxied to the airman who, after a strenuous effort, was hauled aboard. Owing to the heavy seas, it was not possible for the aircraft to take off again, so, disregarding enemy minefields in the vicinity and the possibility of attack from the air, Flight Lieutenant Spence resourcefully taxied his aircraft across the Channel to a home base. His gallant achievement was worthy of high praise.

Distinguished Flying Cross.

Wing Commander Rupert Francis Henry CLERKE (36108), No. 125 Squadron.

This officer is a skilful and determined fighter. He has personally destroyed 4 enemy aircraft, 2 of them at night, and shared in the destruction of 3 others. His keenness has been noteworthy.

Acting Squadron Leader Hugh Selmes JACKSON (63098), Royal Air Force Volunteer Reserve, No. 125 Squadron.

This officer has participated in a large number of sorties, including many fighter/bomber attacks on targets in Pantellaria, Sicily and Lampedusa. He has on several occasions led fighter formations detailed to act as escort to bomber forces and his skilful work has contributed materially to the success of the operation. In May, 1943, Squadron Leader Jackson took part in a highly successful reconnaissance of Pantellaria, the island being fully reconnoitred at a low level. Anti-aircraft fire was encountered throughout the whole operation. On 2 occasions in June, 1943, in engagements against hostile aircraft, Squadron Leader Jackson displayed great skill and tenacity. His keenness and devotion to duty have been outstanding.

Acting Squadron Leader Raymond Arthur Vernon SALMON (67675), Royal Air Force Volunteer Reserve, No. 40 Squadron.

This officer, who has completed very many sorties, has displayed leadership and skill of a high degree. One night in April, 1943, he participated in an attack on an airfield in Tunis. Although his aircraft was repeatedly hit by fire from the ground defences, Squadron Leader Salmon made several runs over the target to complete his task successfully. His determination was typical of the manner in which he invariably undertakes his tasks.

Acting Flight Lieutenant Leslie William WATTS (117728), Royal Air Force Volunteer Reserve, No. 616 Squadron.

This officer has completed a large number of sorties, many of which were undertaken during the intensive air operations over Malta where he

fought with great determination. On 1 occasion he led a formation against a superior number of enemy aircraft which were attacking a convoy. In the ensuing combat, 2 of the enemy bombers were destroyed, 1 of them by Flight Lieutenant Watts, while the remainder were driven off after being forced to jettison their bombs. More recently, in May, 1943, during an attack on shipping in the English Channel, Flight Lieutenant Watts flew with great distinction. This officer has invariably displayed courage, skill and tenacity.

Flying Officer Peter David John Wood (123622), Royal Air Force Volunteer Reserve, No. 605 Squadron.

Flying Officer Wood is a navigator of high merit. He has participated in many sorties and has contributed to the destruction of 3 enemy aircraft. Flying Officer Wood has rendered valuable service.

Acting Flight Lieutenant Vaughan Francis GANDERTON (Can/J.10133), Royal Canadian Air Force, No. 427 (R.C.A.F.) Squadron.

One night in June, 1943, this officer piloted an aircraft detailed to attack a target in the Ruhr. During the operation the bomber was severely damaged by gunfire when attacked by an enemy fighter. Although the entire rudder control was shot away, Flight Lieutenant Ganderton, displaying superb skill, succeeded in flying the damaged bomber back to this country. In the face of a perilous situation, this officer displayed commendable courage and determination.

Flying Officer Frank William HORRY, D.F.M. (47882), No. 40 Squadron.

This officer has completed a large number of sorties many of them in the Middle East. He has rendered valuable service, attacking his targets with great determination and often obtaining good photographs. His outstanding keenness was well illustrated on 1 occasion in June, when his aircraft was involved in a crash on the runway owing to a punctured tyre. Despite this, Flying Officer Horry took part in an operation the following night, fulfilling his duties with zeal. He has set a courageous example.

Flying Officer John Gwynedd WYNNE (117666), Royal Air Force Volunteer Reserve, No. 40 Squadron.

This officer has completed many sorties, including numerous air operations over Tunisia. He has invariably displayed outstanding determination, setting an example worthy of emulation. This was amply demonstrated during the outward flight on an operational mission, in May, 1943, when engine trouble developed and Flying Officer Wynne was compelled to return to base. Whilst over the airfield, the engines began to function properly. Thereupon, Flying Officer Wynne again set course for his target and bombed it successfully. Owing to shortage of petrol on the return route he made a landing at another airfield. Flying Officer Wynne displayed great devotion to duty.

Pilot Officer Frank Graham CRACKNELL (Aus.401813), Royal Australian Air Force, No. 100 Squadron.

This officer has undertaken numerous sorties against targets in the strongly defended Ruhr area. He has displayed outstanding devotion to duty, pressing home his attacks with vigour. One night in May, 1943, on the outward flight to Wuppertal, 1 engine of his aircraft failed. Although the bomber lost some height, Pilot Officer Cracknell continued to the target to execute a successful attack. He is a skilful and courageous captain.

Pilot Officer Stanley SLATER (145503), Royal Air Force Volunteer Reserve, No. 100 Squadron.

This officer has completed many sorties against various targets in the Ruhr and has invariably displayed skill and determination in pressing home his attacks. On 1 occasion after a successful attack on Spezia in Italy, his aircraft was engaged by enemy fighters on the return flight, but he skilfully out-manoeuvred them and reached base. On 2 subsequent occasions, on the outward flight to his target, engine trouble has been experienced but Pilot Officer Slater displayed fine airmanship and completed his missions successfully. He has rendered excellent service.

Squadron Leader Wallace Ivor LASHBROOK, D.F.M. (45895), No. 102 Squadron.

Flying Officer Alfred MARTIN (120240), Royal Air Force Volunteer Reserve, No. 102 Squadron.

In air operations, these officers and airman have displayed conduct in keeping with the highest traditions of the Royal Air Force.

One night in June, 1943, Flying Officer Hearn and Sergeants Pointon and Wilkinson were air bomber, mid-upper gunner and flight engineer respectively of an aircraft, piloted by Sergeant Wilkie, detailed to attack Cologne. Whilst over the target area, the bomber was hit by anti-aircraft fire. The windscreen round the pilot's cabin was shattered and Sergeant Wilkie was blinded by flying splinters. Despite this he remained at the controls. Flying Officer Hearn and Sergeant Wilkinson were injured by fragments of shrapnel. Nevertheless, the former uncomplainingly remained at his post ready to release his bombs whilst Sergeant Wilkinson went to the assistance of his pilot and the bombing run was completed. Still unable to see, Sergeant Wilkie remained at the controls, piloting his aircraft by touch, being aided in various ways by the flight engineer and by Flying Officer Hearn who directed him in avoiding the searchlights and continuous anti-aircraft fire to which the bomber was subjected. Some time later, whilst still over enemy territory, Sergeant Wilkie recovered his vision in one eye and soon succeeded in flying clear of the defences, afterwards flying the aircraft back to this country. In the course of the action Sergeant Pointon had one finger severed when his turret was damaged by a shattering blow. Although in considerable pain he remained at his post, constantly alert to the danger of fighter interference. In most harassing circumstances these members of aircraft crew displayed courage, fortitude and determination of the highest order.

Distinguished Flying Cross.

Flying Officer Robert Thomas MERRIFIELD (111567), Royal Air Force Volunteer Reserve, No. 53 Squadron.

Flying Officer Gordon Francis WOOD (Aus.402980), Royal Australian Air Force, No. 53 Squadron.

Distinguished Flying Medal.

755147 Flight Sergeant Roy NIVEN, Royal Air Force Volunteer Reserve, No. 53 Squadron.

In July, 1943, Flying Officers Merrifield and Wood and Flight Sergeant Niven were pilot and beam gunners respectively of an aircraft engaged on an anti-submarine patrol over the Bay of Biscay. During the flight, the bomber was engaged by 4 hostile aircraft. In the running fight which ensued, these members of aircraft crew displayed great courage and tenacity. Coolly and skilfully, Flying Officer Merrifield manoeuvred his aircraft while his beam gunners used their guns most effectively shooting down 2 of the attackers and driving off the others. During the action, which lasted for 47 minutes, these members of aircraft crew set an example worthy of the highest praise.

Conspicuous Gallantry Medal (Flying).

Aus.401206 Sergeant George DOWNTON, Royal Australian Air Force.

This airman was the wireless operator/air gunner of an aircraft which, during a flight near Cap Bon, was engaged by 10 enemy fighters. In the ensuing combat, Sergeant Downton was wounded 3 times, while his gun became unserviceable. Despite this, he coolly directed his pilot in taking the necessary evading action until the aircraft could no longer be flown and was

landed on fire, in enemy territory. With complete disregard of his own safety, Sergeant Downton, who escaped serious injury in the crash, entered the blazing wreckage and assisted in extricating a member of the crew who was badly burned. He then tried valiantly to re-enter the rear of the aircraft to rescue a trapped comrade but was finally beaten by the intense heat of the conflagration. His courageous efforts, in spite of his wounds, were worthy of the highest praise.

1308178 Sergeant Edwin Thomas George HALL, No. 115 Squadron.

Distinguished Flying Medal.

1346616 Sergeant William Porter JOLLY, No. 115 Squadron.

1078262 Sergeant Ray Kingsley CROWTHER, No. 115 Squadron.

Sergeants Hall and Crowther were mid-upper gunner and wireless operator respectively of an aircraft, captained by Sergeant Jolly, which attacked Cologne one night in June, 1943. On the homeward flight the bomber was intercepted by 2 enemy fighters and a running combat ensued. Sergeant Jolly took violent evasive action but, eventually a burst of gunfire from 1 of the attackers, at close range, hit the rear turret, setting the fuselage on fire between the bulkhead doors. Sergeant Hall, the mid-upper gunner, kept firing his guns however, and the enemy aircraft was seen diving steeply and on fire. By this time, the rear turret was well alight and the fuselage became filled with smoke. The situation became critical but Sergeants Hall and Crowther, without waiting to connect the portable oxygen supply, attempted to quell the flames. Both airmen became thoroughly exhausted but gamely battled on and, after a prolonged struggle, succeeded in extinguishing the flames; it was then discovered that the rear turret had fallen off. Eventually, Sergeant Jolly flew the damaged bomber to an airfield in this country, landing it safely. In the face of a critical situation, these members of aircraft crew displayed courage, fortitude and determination of the highest order.

Distinguished Flying Medal.

1267269 Flight Sergeant Donald Clive CHALLIS, No. 40 Squadron.

This officer has taken part in numerous sorties, involving attacks on targets in Pantellaria, Tunisia and Sicily and has displayed a high degree of skill and thoroughness throughout. One night in June, 1943, he attacked dock installations and the port at Pantellaria, causing much damage and starting a large fire which was visible many miles distant. His skill as a pilot has enabled many excellent photographs to be obtained.

756303 Flight Sergeant Kenneth Charles RIDLEY, Royal Air Force Volunteer Reserve, No. 263 Squadron.

This airman has taken part in 30 sorties, involving attacks on airfields, industrial targets, rail communications and shipping. He has displayed great skill and determination throughout and, on 3 occasions, when his aircraft has been severely damaged by enemy action, he has flown it back to base.

1291130 Flight Sergeant John Edward STAPLES, No. 126 Squadron.

This airman has completed a very large number of sorties and has displayed great zeal and ability. On 1 occasion in April, 1943, he took part in an attack on Marzedemi. In spite of intense anti-aircraft fire hits were obtained on sidings, an industrial plant and a large factory. Flight Sergeant Staples is a confident and tenacious pilot.

1388285 Sergeant Cecil Agar LAMBERT, No. 51 Squadron.

One night in July, 1943, this airman captained an aircraft detailed to attack Cologne. When crossing the enemy coast, on the outward flight, the aircraft was hit by fire from the ground defences. The fuselage was holed in several places, while 2 of the petrol tanks were pierced, causing the fuel to leak rapidly. A large fragment of shrapnel crashed through the windscreen of the pilot's cabin, and severed the shoulder strap of Sergeant Lambert's safety harness. With commendable determination, this airman continued

to the target and bombed it, obtaining an excellent photograph and afterwards flying the damaged aircraft to base. Sergeant Lambert displayed a high degree of skill and gallantry.

While returning from an operational sortie, the aircraft in which Flight Sergeant Collins and Sergeant Parker were flying as captain and bomb aimer respectively, developed a fault in one engine and was unable to gain height. On heading out to sea, the aircraft was engaged by heavy anti-aircraft fire, the petrol tanks and a second engine were set on fire. Preparations were made to descend on the sea. While the aircraft was approaching the water, and already burning fiercely, another hit was sustained, which killed the wireless operator and severely wounded Sergeant Parker, who had, throughout, rendered

great assistance to the captain. Flight Sergeant Collins succeeded in bringing the aircraft down on to the water, gaining time for the rest of the crew to board the dinghy. Sergeant Parker continued his duties during the descent and helped in the transfer of the crew before he informed his companions of his wound. Both these airmen displayed great gallantry in an extremely hazardous situation.
