# Air Ministry, 28th September, 1943.

The KING has been graciously pleased to approve the following awards in recognition of gallantry dis-played in flying operations against the enemy:---

#### Distinguished Service Order.

Acting Squadron Leader Walter STERNE (75166), Royal Air Force Volunteer Reserve, No. 283 Squadron.

Squadron. In air/sea rescue operations this officer has rendered most valuable service. During one period of six weeks, the squadron he commands were responsible for the rescue of many members of aircraft crew from the sea around Pantellaria and Sicily. These efforts were made under the supervision and direction of Squadron Leader Sterne who himself effected several of them, in-volving abnormal hazard, near enemy territory. In June, 1943, he undertook a search for a pilot reported adrift in the dinghy. After many hours' flying, Squadron Leader Sterne located the dinghy very close to the Sicilian coast. The sea was ex-tremely rough but, in circumstances which called for the utmost skill, Squadron Leader Sterne effected a successful rescue. This officer has dis-played outstanding leadership and great courage.

- 434099 Sergeant Herbert John WILLIS, Royal Air Force Volunteer Reserve, No. 115 Squadron. One night in September, 1943, Flying Officer Beer and Sergeants Tugwell and Willis were air
- Beer and Sergeants Tugwell and Willis were air bomber, mid-upper gunner and rear gunner re-spectively of an aircraft captained by Squadron Leader Starky and detailed to attack Mannheim. When nearing the target area the aircraft was attacked by a fighter. The bomber was badly hit and sustained much damage. It became filled with smoke and dived earthwards out of control. By a tremendous effort, Squadron Leader Starky succeeded in regaining control as the fighter came succeeded in regaining control as the fighter came in to resume the attack. Sergeants Tugwell and Willis coolly withheld their fire until the attacker came into close range then, with devastating

bursts of fire, shot it down in flames. The situa-tion was critical as the bomber had been badly crippled while the second pilot and flight engineer had been wounded. Nevertheless, on a course plotted by Flying Officer Beer who, throughout the remainder of the homeward flight, rendered great assistance, Squadron Leader Starky battled his way over enemy territory, often under fire from ground defences. Displaying superb airman-ship and an unconquerable spirit he finally reached an airfield near the coast and effected a safe landing. In most harassing circumstances these members of aircraft crew discharged their duties in an exemplary manner, setting an example worthy of the highest praise.

## Second Bar to Distinguished Flying Cross.

Second Bar to Distinguished Flying Cross. Acting Squadron Leader Frederick Desmond Hughrs, D.F.C. (74706), Royal Air Force Volunteer Reserve, No. 600 Squadron. Squadron Leader Hughes is a brilliant night fighter whose determined efforts have met with further successes. Since being awarded a bar to the Distinguished Flying Cross he has destroyed 7 enemy aircraft. His total victories number at least 16, of which 13 have been destroyed at night. Squadron Leader Hughes is a highly efficient flight commander and his meritorious work has been reflected in the efforts of his flight which has earned notable successes. earned notable successes.

#### Bar to Distinguished Flying Cross.

Flying Officer Lawrence DIXON, D.F.C. (116698), Royal Air Force Volunteer Reserve, No 600 Squadron. Flying Officer Dixon is an extremely skilful observer who has assisted in the destruction of at least ro enemy aircraft at night. He has at all times displayed great zeal and has proved himself to be a most valuable member of aircraft crew.

#### Distinguished Flying Cross.

Distinguished Flying Cross. Acting Flight Lieutenan't Joseph Charles Herve DELISLE (Can/J.16655), Royal Canadian Air Force, No. 425 (R.C.A.F.) Squadron. This officer has completed very many sorties during which he has attacked a variety of targets with success. Flight Lieutenant Delisle is a skil-ful pilot whose determination and thoroughness have often been demonstrated. On one occasion his aircraft was hit whilst over the target. The hydraulic system was damaged, causing the under-carriage to fall to the down position, while the bomb doors could not be closed. Flight Lieutenant Delisle flew the damaged aircraft to base where he effected a safe landing although both tyres of the landing wheels were punctured. This officer has displayed great courage and devotion to duty.

Flying Officer William Elliott ARMSTRONG (122555), Royal Air Force Volunteer Reserve, No. 600 Squadron.

As observer, this officer has taken part in a large number of sorties at night and has assisted in the destruction of 4 enemy aircraft. His skill and keenness throughout have been worthy of high praise.

Flying Officer Harold Thomas BROWN (Can/J.13055), Royal Canadian Air Force, No. 419 (R.C.A.F.)

Squadron. One night in August, 1943, this offier piloted an aircraft detailed to attack Nuremburg. Although one engine of the bomber failed early on the outward flight, Flying Officer Brown con-tinued to the target and bombed it successfully. Some nights later, this pilot again flew with dis-tinction in an operation against Berlin. On both occasions he displayed great determination and devotion to duty.

Flying Officer Rex Merville CRONCHEY (122070), Royal Air Force Volunteer Reserve, No. 37

Royal Air Force Volunteer Reserve, No. 37 Squadron. This officer has participated in many sorties and has displayed courage and zeal of a high order. He has executed his tasks with great skill and tenacity which contributed materially to the success of many operations during which several important airfields and marshalling yards have been attacked. His efforts throughout have been of inestimable value and featured by outstanding devotion to duty. duty.

- Flying Officer William LESTER (134334); Royal Air Force Volunteer Reserve, No. 40 Squadron. As navigator, this officer has taken part in a large number of sorties and displayed exceptional ability. One night in July, 1943, he took part in an operation against an airfield at Naples. In spite of much cloud and haze, Flying Officer Lester accomplished excellent work and contributed materially to the success of the operation. On other occasions, when undertaking similar missions, this navigator has achieved much success.
- this navigator has achieved much success. Flying Officer Stewart Thomas SMITH (Can/J.16159), Royal Canadian Air Force, No. 90 Squadron. As rear gunner, this officer has taken part in several sorties. On the latter of these, just as the target had been bombed, his aircraft was attacked by 3 enemy fighters. In the first combat, Flying Officer Smith was wounded in the leg. Despite this, he remained at his guns and fought the at-tackers with great skill, driving off each one of the enemy aircraft in turn. Not until the bomber was well clear of the target area would he leave his turret to receive medical attention. This gal-lant gunner contributed materially to the safe return of the aircraft.
- Pilot Officer James McCUBBIN (149212), Royal Air Force Volunteer Reserve, No. 9 Squadron. This officer has completed very many sorties and has invariably displayed great persistence to achieve success. On more than one occasion his aircraft has been attacked by fighters but Pilot Officer McCubbin has displayed great skill to out-manceuvre the enemy aircraft and return safely to base. He has displayed inspiring leadership and great courage. great courage.

were pilot and observer respectively of the leading aircraft of a formation which attached a medium aircraft of a formation which attached a medium sized ship near Preveza harbour in August, 1943. The attack was pressed home with great vigour and the vessel was hit repeatedly. Afterwards, Flight Lieutenant Faulkner attacked a tug leaving the harbour. On the return flight, this pilot attacked a heavily armed vessel. Although his aircraft was hit, Flight Lieutenant Faulkner pressed home a determined attack. Throughout the operations, Sergeant Goodes accomplished much good work and obtained excellent photo-graphs. These members of aircraft crew displayed preat courage and resolution. great courage and resolution.

## Distinguished Flying Cross.

This officer and airman were pilot and rear gunner respectively of an aircraft detailed to attack Berlin one night in August, 1943. Shortly after the bombs had been released, the aircraft was attacked by 3 enemy fighters. Flight Lieutenant Day cleverly manoeuvred his aircraft Lieutenant Day cleverly manoeuvred his aircraft while Flight Sergeant Mitchinson fought resolutely to frustrate the attackers, one of which he shot down. The bomber had been bit, however, receiv-ing damage to one of the petrol tanks, which caused it contents to leak rapidly. One of the engines became defective and had to be feathered but, displaying great skill and determination, Flight Lieutenant Day battled on to reach this country. These members of aircraft crew set a worthy example.

### Distinguished Flying Medal.

This airman has completed many sorties, includ-ing several attacks on important marshalling yards which he has bombed with great success, afterwards diving to a low level to rake the target with machine-gun fire. In all his opera-tions, this airman has displayed great skill and dash setting a very couragedus example. He has dash, setting a very courageous example. He has rendered most valuable service. 1268030 Flight Sergeant Herbert Blackmore Marshall, Royal Air Force Volunteer Reserve,

MARSHALL, Royal Air Force Volunteer Reserve, No. 158 Squadron. This airman has taken part in many sorties over well defended areas, including Berlin. One night in August, 1943, he piloted an aircraft detailed for an operation against Nuremburg. Before the target was reached, one of the bomber's engines became useless. Although the aircraft lost some height, Flight Sergeant Marshall continued to the target and bombed it, afterwards flying the airtarget and bombed it, afterwards flying the air-craft to base. His skill and tenacity were highly commendable.

1750283 Sergeant John Norman Stephen Astron, Royal Air Force Volunteer Reserve, No. 419 (R.C.A.F.) Squadron. This airman was flight engineer of an aircraft detailed to attack Munchen-Gladbach one night in

detailed to attack Munchen-Gladbach one night in August, 1943. Soon after leaving the target the bomber was hit by fire from an enemy fighter. Some batteries were set alight, the flames sweeping back along the fuselage. Displaying great promptitude, Sergeant Ashton sprayed the flames around the batteries with an extinguisher until they subsided. Having secured another ex-tinguisher he went to mid position and raised the bomb bay inspection panels to investigate further. Flames immediately blazed up into his face. With his gloved hands he held and rotated the ex-tinguisher in an opening in the floor so that the wind in the slip stream sprayed the fluid around the bomb bay and thus the flames were put out. By his promptitude and resource this gallant airman contributed materially to the safe return of the aircraft. of the aircraft.

1297387 Sergeant Norman Leslie Ernest GALE, Royal Air Force Volunteer Reserve, No. 106

Squadron. This airman was the flight engineer of an air-craft detailed to attack Berlin one night in August, 1943. Whilst over the city, the aircraft was hit by anti-aircraft fire. Much damage was sustained, including one of the petrol tanks which was badly pierced causing its contents to randidu leak away Despite this, the pilot completed his body place away. Despite this, the pilot completed his bombing run before setting course for home. During the return flight, Sergeant Gale executed his tasks with great skill and zeal, proving of material assistance to his pilot. Soon after the English coast was crossed the petrol became exhausted and the pilot was compelled to attempt a crash-landing. When near to the ground the aircraft struck some obstacles before finally coming to rest in a field where it became wrecked and caught fire. Sergeant Gale got clear and made gallant efforts to rescue other

members of the crew. Thrice he entered the wreckage and was successful in assisting 2 of his injured comrades to safety. This airman displayed exemplary conduct throughout and his gallant efforts in harassing circumstances were worthy of high project high praise.

1433893 Sergeant William Surtees LAMBERT, Royal Air Force Volunteer Reserve, No. 283 Squadron. In June, 1943, this airman piloted an aircraft to the aid of 4 members of a bomber crew who were in their dinghy and drifting near the enemy coast. in their dinghy and drifting near the enemy coast. The sea was exceedingly rough, making the task of alighting his aircraft on the water very hazardous. Nevertheless, Sergeant Lambert accomplished the feat and took his comrades aboard. It was impossible to take-off again but Sergeant Lambert resourcefully taxied the aircraft for some 50 miles before being towed by a launch for the remainder of the homeward journey. In circumstances of great difficulty this airman displayed courage and resource of a bigh order. resource of a high order.

resource of a high order. 1815007 Sergeant Austin John SARGEANT, Royal Air Force Volunteer Reserve, No. 106 Squadron. One night in September, 1943, this airman was the flight engineer of an airc aft detailed to attack Berlin. Whilst over the city the aircraft was repeatedly hit by fire from a fighter. The rear gunner and bomb aimer were seriously wounded while Sergeant Sargeant was hit in the knee by fragments of cannon shell. The inter-communica-tion was rendered unserviceable but Sargeant. who fragments of cannon shell. The inter-communica-tion was rendered unserviceable but Sargeant, who told his captain that he was unhurt, made contact with his injured comrades, tended to them and then coolly resumed his duties. Later, whilst over the sea, the pilot was compelled to bring his air-craft down on to the water and acting on his own initiative, during the descent Sargeant jettisoned much moveable equipment in an effort to lighten the aircraft. After 6 hours in the dinghy an air-borne lifeboat was dropped to the crew and it was only when they were transferring to it that the captain became aware of the flight engineer's injury. This airman displayed great fortitude, courage and devotion to oduty in very trying circumstances. circumstances.
