The KING has been graciously pleased to approve the following awards in recognition of gallantry displayed in flying operations against the enemy:—

Distinguished Service Order.

Acting Flight Lieutenant Dudley MARROWS, D.F.C. (Aus.400656), Royal Australian Air Force, No. 461 (R.A.A.F.) Squadron.

Distinguished Flying Medal.

Aus.10530 Sergeant Fred BAMBER, Royal Australian Air Force, No. 461 (R.A.A.F.) Squadron.

Aus.14455 Sergeant Alan Neale PEARCE, Royal Australian Air Force, No. 461 (R.A.A.F.) Squadron.

As pilot and air gunners respectively, this officer and airmen have undertaken many sorties and have displayed great skill and devotion to duty throughout. On a recent occasion, whilst flying over enemy waters, their aircraft was intercepted by six Junkers 88s. In the ensuing engagement, Flight Lieutenant Marrows fought with great skill and determination. Well supported by his gunners he frustrated the attackers for more than an hour until, with three engines shot away and all but one gun silenced, he was forced to bring his aircraft down on to the water. Although a heavy sea was running the crew succeeded in getting aboard the one remaining dinghy. During the action, Sergeant Bamber had been badly wounded but, whilst in the dinghy, set a fine example of cheerfulness and resolution until a rescue was subsequently effected. Throughout this spirited action, Flight Lieutenant Marrows displayed inspiring leadership, great courage and determination; Sergeant Pearce also fought with rare zest and subsequently displayed coolness and resource when the aircraft had to be abandoned.

Bar to Distinguished Flying Cross.

Acting Wing Commander Walter Harry SHAW, D.F.C. (40146), Reserve of Air Force Officers, No. 83 Squadron.

Since being awarded the Distinguished Flying Cross this officer has undertaken many sorties, including attacks on such targets as Berlin, Turin and Genoa. In August, 1943, he participated in an operation against Nuremburg when he pressed home a determined attack and obtained excellent photographic evidence of his work. Wing-Commander Shaw has displayed great zest for operations and his example of determination and devotion to duty has been most commendable.

Acting Squadron Leader Norman Frederick HILDYARD, D.F.C. (84917), Royal Air Force Volunteer Reserve, No. 83 Squadron.

This officer has completed very many sorties since being awarded the Distinguished Flying Cross. On a recent occasion he piloted an aircraft de-

tailed to attack Nuremburg. During the bombing run, the aircraft was illuminated by the searchlights but, after several minutes, Squadron Leader Hildyard flew clear and executed another run over the target which was bombed with accuracy. This officer has displayed great skill and unflinching devotion to duty.

Acting Flight Lieutenant John Francis HACKING, D.F.C. (143428), Royal Air Force Volunteer Reserve, No. 83 Squadron.

Flight Lieutenant Hacking is a navigator of exceptional skill, whose brilliant work has contributed in a large measure to the successful bombing of many important enemy targets. In addition to his successes in the air, Flight Lieutenant Hacking has devoted his energies towards the training of many navigators of the squadron. This officer has set a most praiseworthy example.

Acting Flight Lieutenant Harold Phillip MASON, D.F.C. (Aus.403522), Royal Australian Air Force, No. 83 Squadron.

This officer, who has completed a very large number of sorties, has displayed high qualities of leadership and outstanding skill. His unflinching determination was amply demonstrated during a recent operation against Berlin when, in the face of heavy opposition he pressed home his attack with great accuracy. Flight Lieutenant Mason has set a very fine example.

Distinguished Flying Cross.

Acting Squadron Leader David Beatty HODGKINSON (41410), Reserve of Air Force Officers, No. 179 Squadron.

One night in September, 1943, this officer captained an aircraft which successfully attacked a U-boat in the Mediterranean sea. Despite heavy anti-aircraft fire from the submarine's guns, Squadron Leader Hodgkinson pressed home his attack with accuracy and determination. This officer has completed numerous sorties and has displayed inspiring leadership, great courage and devotion to duty.

Acting Squadron Leader Robert Richard MEGGINSON, D.F.M. (84708), Royal Air Force Volunteer Reserve, No. 15 Squadron.

This officer is a highly efficient and resolute captain. He has taken part in a very large number of sorties and has always endeavoured to press home his attacks, often in the face of heavy opposition. One night in August, 1943, Squadron Leader Megginson piloted an aircraft detailed for an operation against Berlin. Whilst over the city the aircraft was attacked by fighters and sustained damage. Despite this, Squadron Leader Megginson bombed his target and afterwards flew the aircraft to base. His skill and resolution set a fine example.

Acting Flight Lieutenant Maurice Rendall CHICK (49191), Royal Air Force, No. 83 Squadron.

This officer has participated in a large number of sorties during which his fearlessness and skill have earned him many successes. His efficiency and resolution have been reflected in the high morale of his crew.

Acting Flight Lieutenant Stanley Joseph COLEMAN, D.F.M. (129714), Royal Air Force Volunteer Reserve, No. 83 Squadron.

As bomb aimer, Flight Lieutenant Coleman has taken part in a very large number of sorties, involving attacks on a wide range of well defended targets. His sterling work throughout has been highly commendable and he has set an example worthy of emulation.

Acting Flight Lieutenant Jean Paul Etienne MAZE (124788), Royal Air Force Volunteer Reserve, No. 76 Squadron.

One night in August, 1943, this officer piloted an aircraft detailed to attack Milan. During the flight the aircraft was attacked by a fighter. Although 1 engine was damaged and caught fire, while the elevator trimming controls were rendered useless, Flight Lieutenant Maze succeeded in evading the attacker. After extinguishing the fire and feathering the propeller of the defective engine, Flight Lieutenant Maze set course for this country and eventually reached an airfield near the coast where he effected a masterly landing. Flight Lieutenant Maze displayed great skill, courage and coolness throughout. This officer has completed very many sorties and has always endeavoured to press home his attacks with vigour.

Acting Flight Lieutenant Wilmot Reginald PETTIT (Can./J15517), Royal Canadian Air Force, No. 199 Squadron.

As pilot, this officer has participated in many attacks on important enemy targets and has displayed great skill and determination. On a recent occasion, whilst over Berlin, his aircraft was hit by fire from the ground defences but he continued his bombing run to execute a successful attack. Shortly afterwards the bomber was again hit, this time by fire from an enemy fighter. The rear turret was rendered unserviceable, most of the electrical system was shot away, while the control wires of 2 petrol tanks were severed. Coolly and skilfully, Flight Lieutenant Pettit evaded the attacker and afterwards flew the bomber to base. This officer displayed great courage and determination throughout.

Acting Flight Lieutenant Walter Ramon THOMPSON (Can./J10506), Royal Canadian Air Force, No. 83 Squadron.

This officer is a first-class pilot whose determined work has been worthy of great praise. He has undertaken many sorties and throughout has endeavoured to press home his attacks whatever the opposition. On a recent occasion, during an operation against Berlin, Flight Lieutenant Thompson accomplished his purpose with great skill. He is a fine captain whose example has proved inspiring.

Flying Officer James David BELL (Can./J11221), Royal Canadian Air Force, No. 218 Squadron.

This officer is a navigator of high merit. He has completed a large number of sorties and his efforts have contributed much to the successes obtained. On a recent occasion, during a flight to Berlin, an electrical storm was encountered. Displaying great skill, Flying Officer Bell unerringly guided his pilot to the target which was successfully bombed. This officer has displayed commendable courage and resource.

Flying Officer Allan BRODIE (132391), Royal Air Force Volunteer Reserve, No. 40 Squadron.

As bomb aimer, this officer has completed a large number of sorties, involving attacks on targets in Tunisia, Pantellaria and, more recently, in Italy. Flying Officer Brodie is a fearless and skilful member of aircraft crew, whose excellent work has been worthy of high praise. On one occasion, during an attack on a well defended airfield in Tunisia, the aircraft was hit by anti-aircraft fire. The bombing panel was shattered, Flying Officer Brodie being covered with the splintered glass, but in spite of this he coolly and skilfully executed his bombing. His example has proved most inspiring.

Flying Officer Joseph Henry COLEY (142908), Royal Air Force Volunteer Reserve, No. 83 Squadron.

Flying Officer Coley is an air gunner of high merit. He has taken part in a large number of sorties and, on more than one occasion, his excellent work has contributed materially to the safe return of his aircraft. His constant vigilance, skill and resolution have made him a valuable member of aircraft crew.

Flying Officer Donald Farquhar McRAE (Can./J.9405), Royal Canadian Air Force, No. 179 Squadron.

Flying Officer Reginald Kenneth SENIOR (Aus. 408706), Royal Australian Air Force, No. 179 Squadron.

Flying Officers McRae and Senior as captain and wireless operator/air gunner respectively, have flown on many anti-submarine patrols and, recently, have successfully executed three attacks on enemy submarines. On the latter of these, Flying Officer McRae, displaying brilliant airmanship, executed his attack with great precision from a height of 100 feet. This officer has displayed great courage and tenacity and his efforts have been well supported by Flying Officer Senior, whose skilful work has been of a high order. These officers have set an unsurpassed example of keenness and devotion to duty.

Flying Officer Eric John PHILLIPS (130236), Royal Air Force Volunteer Reserve, No. 15 Squadron.

Pilot Officer Goldwin Wilbur GABEL (Can./J.17528), Royal Canadian Air Force, No. 15 Squadron.

One night in July, 1943, these officers were rear gunner and pilot respectively of an aircraft detailed to attack a target in the Ruhr. During the operation the aircraft was hit by cannon fire from a fighter. The rear turret was rendered unserviceable and Flying Officer Phillips was wounded in the face and chest. One of the bomber's engines had caught fire and Pilot Officer Gabel tried to feather the propeller. He was unable to do so, however, and the situation became serious. Suddenly the propeller fell away and the flames in the burning engine died away. Displaying great skill and tenacity, Pilot Officer Gabel battled on to eventually reach base. In spite of his injuries, Flying Officer Phillips displayed great fortitude and devotion to duty and remained on watch in the astro-hatch throughout the return flight. On a later occasion Pilot Officer Gabel flew his aircraft from Turin with one engine useless. This officer has displayed skill, courage and coolness of a high order.

Flying Officer Richard Lawrence WESTINGHOUSE (108984), Royal Air Force Volunteer Reserve, No. 680 Squadron.

This officer has undertaken a very large number of reconnaissances and has displayed skill and devotion to duty of a high order. In September, 1943, he executed a reconnaissance over a very extensive area and obtained valuable results. His efforts on this occasion were worthy of the highest praise.

Pilot Officer Geoffrey William Clifton CANDLIN, D.F.M. (146286), Royal Air Force Volunteer Reserve, No. 83 Squadron.

As bomb aimer, Pilot Officer Candlin has participated in a large number of sorties and his skilful efforts have contributed in a large measure to the successful bombing of many important targets. In addition, Pilot Officer Candlin has devoted his energies towards the training of other members of aircraft crew, rendering excellent service. His fine record is worthy of great praise.

Pilot Officer Stewart Foster GARLAND (Can./J.16208), Royal Canadian Air Force, No. 40 Squadron.

This officer is an extremely keen and efficient captain, who has earned many successes. One night in July, 1943, he executed a most successful attack on the marshalling yards at Reggio Di Calabria. Although his aircraft was hit by anti-aircraft fire during the bombing run, Pilot Officer Garland pressed home his attack, starting many fires; he also secured an excellent photograph. His high morale and fine record have set an excellent example.

Pilot Officer Roland KING (Aus. 415154), Royal Australian Air Force, No. 83 Squadron.

This officer is a skilful pilot whose determined efforts when attacking such targets as Berlin, Essen, Hamburg and Nuremberg have been worthy of high praise. On the latter occasion his

aircraft was damaged by anti-aircraft fire whilst over the target. Despite this, Pilot Officer King pressed home his attack and afterwards flew the damaged bomber to base where he effected a masterly landing. He has displayed great courage and devotion to duty.

Pilot Officer William Francis Cyril KNIGHT (155475), Royal Air Force Volunteer Reserve, No. 218 Squadron.

One night in August, 1943, this officer piloted an aircraft detailed to attack Berlin. Just before reaching the target area whilst evading a fighter, Pilot Officer Knight saw another bomber being attacked by an enemy aircraft. Displaying commendable resource he dived to the attack and his front gunner drove off the enemy, thus enabling the second bomber to continue its mission. Pilot Officer Knight has taken part in many sorties against well defended targets and has pressed home his attacks with great determination. He has displayed great courage and devotion to duty.

Pilot Officer Donald Arthur MESSINGHAM (147707), Royal Air Force Volunteer Reserve, No. 23 Squadron.

This officer is a navigator of exceptional ability. He has taken part in very many sorties, during which rail installations, locomotives and shipping have been attacked with success. His work has been of a high standard throughout and has been reflected in the successes obtained.

Pilot Officer Peter Raymonde RUDD (147777), Royal Air Force Volunteer Reserve, No. 23 Squadron.

Pilot Officer Rudd is a tenacious and skilful pilot. In the course of his many sorties he has attacked locomotives, railway installations and shipping. On one occasion, in Sicily, he attacked an ammunition dump with complete success. On another occasion he shot down a Messerschmitt 210 whilst returning from a patrol. His keenness and efficiency have been highly commendable.

Pilot Officer William Lawrence WEBSTER (149900), Royal Air Force Volunteer Reserve, No. 83 Squadron.

This officer is a flight engineer of considerable skill. He has taken part in a large number of sorties and his efforts have contributed materially to the successes achieved. His keenness and exemplary conduct have been outstanding.

Acting Warrant Officer Paul Fulton CHESTERTON (1383472), Royal Air Force Volunteer Reserve, No. 103 Squadron.

As captain of aircraft, Warrant Officer Chesterton has undertaken many sorties over German territory and has attacked his targets fearlessly and skilfully, setting a very fine example. His great fighting spirit was amply demonstrated on one occasion when detailed to attack Oberhausen in June, 1943. When approaching the target area, the bomber was hit by anti-aircraft fire whilst illuminated by the searchlights. The elevator controls were severed and the ailerons became jammed, causing the aircraft to become temporarily unmanageable. Considerable height was lost before Warrant Officer Chesterton regained control. Undaunted, he went on to execute a determined attack. Displaying superb airmanship, this pilot succeeded in flying the badly damaged bomber to base. His courage and tenacity in the face of hazardous circumstances were beyond praise.

Distinguished Flying Medal

1179652 Flight Sergeant Albert William John HAZELL, Royal Air Force Volunteer Reserve, No. 236 Squadron.

This airman has completed very many sorties and has displayed great dash and determination in pressing home his attacks. In September, 1943, he participated in an attack on a heavily armed enemy convoy and his excellent efforts contributed materially to the success achieved. His keenness and devotion to duty have been most praiseworthy.

Can/R.135881 Flight Sergeant Robert Benjamin HICKS, Royal Canadian Air Force, No. 83 Squadron.

Flight Sergeant Hicks is an air gunner of high merit. He has taken part in a large number of sorties and his skill and coolness in the face of enemy fire have been amply demonstrated on numerous occasions. He has proved himself to be a most dependable member of aircraft crew.

1093924 Flight Sergeant Charles Alfred KIRKHAM, Royal Air Force Volunteer Reserve, No. 76 Squadron.

1497991 Sergeant Alexander Bradford WARD, Royal Air Force Volunteer Reserve, No. 76 Squadron.

Flight Sergeant Kirkham and Sergeants Foster and Ward were pilot, navigator and bomb aimer respectively of an aircraft detailed to attack Rheydt one night in August, 1943. When turning away from the target the bomber was raked by machine gun fire from a fighter. Flight Sergeant Kirkham was hit in the buttock and Sergeant Foster in the leg and the eye. The enemy aircraft made repeated attacks, but Flight Sergeant Kirkham evaded them and eventually flew clear. One of the bomber's engines had been put out of action and much essential equipment was damaged. A fire had started in the interior but fortunately did not spread; part of the outer covering of the aircraft also caught alight but Flight Sergeant Kirkham dived violently and the wind extinguished the flames. At the first opportunity, Sergeant Ward rendered first aid to the severely wounded navigator who had gallantly held to his post. Later Sergeant Ward took over the controls for a short spell while the pilot attended to his own wound. Flight Sergeant Kirkham finally flew the badly damaged bomber to this country and effected a crash landing at an airfield near the coast. In very trying circumstances these gallant airmen displayed courage, fortitude and determination of a high order.

N.Z. 41599. Flight Sergeant Pat MENZIES, Royal New Zealand Air Force, No. 83 Squadron.

As air gunner, Flight Sergeant Menzies has participated in very many sorties against strongly defended objectives. He has at all times displayed great coolness, while his vigilance and skill have, on more than one occasion, contributed materially to the safe return of his aircraft. He has set a praiseworthy example of courage and devotion to duty.

Aus.409321. Flight Sergeant William Yorke RICHARDSON, Royal Australian Air Force, No. 254 Squadron.

In September, 1943, this airman piloted an aircraft detailed to attack enemy shipping. During the operation the aircraft was hit by a shell. The wing tip was shattered, while the aileron became temporarily jammed. Nevertheless, Flight Sergeant Richardson retained control of the damaged aircraft and flew it to base. This airman has taken part in numerous sorties and his efficiency and keenness have been outstanding.

1390182. Flight Sergeant Jack William SLAUGHTER, Royal Air Force Volunteer Reserve, No. 83 Squadron.

This airman is a navigator of exceptional skill. He has completed many sorties, including several to far distant targets, and his excellent work has contributed materially to the successes achieved. Flight Sergeant Slaughter has displayed commendable coolness and courage and his confident example has proved inspiring.

1468513 Sergeant Kenneth James BAKER, Royal Air Force Volunteer Reserve, No. 15 Squadron.

One night in August, 1943, Sergeant Baker was the air bomber of an aircraft detailed to attack Munchen Gladbach. When leaving the target area the aircraft was engaged by a fighter and hit in several places by cannon shells, one of which killed the flight engineer. One of the petrol lines was pierced, causing a large quantity of petrol to leak away. Sergeant Baker, displaying praiseworthy initiative, took over the duties of his dead comrade. He correctly controlled the petrol cocks, thus conserving a considerable amount of fuel, and during the return flight kept close watch on the petrol lines. By his good judgment he assisted materially in the safe return of the aircraft. His coolness and initiative set an excellent example.

1389701 Sergeant Anthony Vernon RIPPENGAL, Royal Air Force Volunteer Reserve, No. 40 Squadron.

This airman is an outstanding captain, whose skill and keenness have been reflected in the many successes he has obtained. One night in June, 1943, he piloted an aircraft detailed to attack the dock area at Cagliari in Sardinia. Executing his task with great determination, Sergeant Rippengal

heavily bombed his target, causing fires which could be seen from very many miles distant. His efforts were worthy of great praise.
