

We, the Ecclesiastical Commissioners for England, acting in pursuance of the Act of the 29th and 30th years of Her late Majesty Queen Victoria, chapter III, do hereby grant out of our common fund to the incumbent of the benefice of Over Whitacre, in the diocese of Birmingham, and to his successors incumbents of the same benefice, one yearly sum or stipend of £149 to be calculated as from the 26th of June, 1943: Provided always, that if at any time lands, or other hereditaments sufficient in our

opinion to produce the said yearly sum or stipend, or any part thereof, shall be annexed by us to the said benefice, in substitution for such yearly sum or stipend, or for such part thereof, our liability for the payment of such yearly sum or stipend, or of such part thereof, as the case may be, shall thereupon and thereafter cease and determine.

We, the Ecclesiastical Commissioners for England, acting in pursuance of the Act of the 29th and 30th years of Her late Majesty Queen Victoria, chapter III, do hereby grant out of our common fund to each of the benefices specified in the schedule hereto in consideration in each case of the benefaction described in the third column of the schedule the capital sum stated opposite to the name of each benefice in the fifth column of the schedule, in respect of which benefaction and capital sum where and so long as the same remain in our hands there shall be paid by us to the Incumbent for the time being of the Benefice the yearly sum stated in the

fourth and sixth columns respectively of the schedule or a proportionate part thereof in respect of the said capital sums so remaining, such yearly sum to begin in each case from the date stated in the seventh column of the schedule.

Provided always that this Instrument which has been executed in several parts, one part for each diocese concerned, shall operate only as a single grant in favour of each of the benefices specified in the schedule.
