## CITY OF WAKEFIELD.

UNDER the Special Enactments (Extension of Time) Act, 1940, the Minister of War Transport has made an Order extending for a period of three years the time limited, by section 6. of the Wakefield Corporation Act, 1938, for the compulsory acquisition, authorised by section 5 (a) of the Act of 1938, of the lands required for the purposes of street improvements.
