The KING has been graciously pleased to approve the following awards in recognition of gallantry displayed in flying operations against the enemy:—

*Distinguished Service Order.*

Acting Wing Commander Richard Geoffrey ENGLAND, D.F.C. (90392), Auxiliary Air Force, No. 107 Squadron.

This officer has taken part in a very large number of sorties including attacks on important targets in Northern France. In August, 1943, Wing Commander England led a formation of aircraft in an attack on a target at Rennes. Bad weather was encountered on the outward flight but Wing Commander England unerringly led his force to the precise target which was successfully attacked from a low level. Some days later, this officer led a bomber force in an attack on a works at Demain. In spite of poor visibility and in the face of intense anti-aircraft fire, the objective was bombed accurately. Much of the success of these operations can be attributed to Wing Commander England's inspiring leadership, great courage and exceptional skill.

Acting Wing Commander Raymond Hiley HARRIES, D.F.C. (87447), Royal Air Force Volunteer Reserve.

This officer is an exceptionally skilful, courageous and determined fighter. Within the past weeks he has led his fighter force on various sorties during which 27 enemy aircraft have been shot down, 3 of them by his own guns. These successes pay an excellent tribute to this officer's inspiring leadership and great tactical ability. Wing Commander Harries has destroyed at least 15 enemy aircraft.

*Distinguished Flying Cross.*

Acting Squadron Leader Michael Crofton BLACK (110650), Royal Air Force Volunteer Reserve, No. 10 Squadron.

This officer has undertaken very many sorties during which he has successfully attacked various industrial centres in the Ruhr and other important targets. Throughout, his efforts have been characterised by great tenacity, while on more than one occasion his superb airmanship has been responsible for the safe return of his aircraft. Squadron Leader Black is a most efficient captain whose personal example has proved a source of inspiration.

Acting Squadron Leader Eric George DEAN (42599), Royal Air Force, No. 10 Squadron.

This officer has taken part in a very large number of sorties many of them in the Middle East. He is a most efficient captain, whose determination to complete his tasks successfully has

been most praiseworthy. During a recent attack on Frankfurt, his aircraft was damaged by anti-aircraft fire but he skilfully flew it back to base. He has displayed unfailing devotion to duty.

Acting Squadron Leader Charles Cecil MORAN (Can/C.1063), Royal Canadian Air Force, No. 418 (R.C.A.F.) Squadron.

This officer has undertaken very many sorties at night and has attacked enemy airfields with much success. During these operations he has also shot down 2 enemy aircraft. In the latter of these combats, which occurred recently, Squadron Leader Moran pressed home his attack from close range, delivering a burst of fire which caused the enemy aircraft to explode in the air. His own aircraft was damaged by the force of the explosion but he flew it to within a few miles of the English coast before he was forced to abandon the aircraft when one of its engines caught fire. His efforts were typical of the tenacity and courage which has always been a feature of his work.

Flight Lieutenant Edward Nigel BUNTING (60523), Royal Air Force Volunteer Reserve, No. 604 Squadron.

This officer has completed a large number of sorties at night and has destroyed 3 enemy aircraft. He is a keen and determined fighter, whose skill and devotion to duty have set an inspiring example.

Flight Lieutenant John Finch McEWEN (77923), Royal Air Force Volunteer Reserve, No. 120 Squadron.

This officer has completed a very large number of sorties, many of them in the Middle East. Latterly, he has undertaken numerous anti-submarine and convoy escort patrols and, in the course of these duties has attacked 3 U-boats. In the latter instance, Flight Lieutenant McEwen pressed home a most vigorous attack in the face of heavy fire from the vessel. This officer has rendered excellent service.

Flight Lieutenant Arthur George PATSTON (103000), Royal Air Force Volunteer Reserve, No. 85 Squadron.

As observer, Flight Lieutenant Patston has participated in a large number of sorties and has assisted in the destruction of 3 enemy aircraft at night. He is a most efficient member of aircraft crew, whose example of courage and devotion to duty has won great praise.

Flight Lieutenant John Naunton ROWLAND (33577), Royal Air Force, No. 12 Squadron.

Flight Lieutenant Rowland has completed very many sorties and has displayed outstanding determination and devotion to duty. On 2 recent occasions, when attacking Hanover, his aircraft has been damaged in encounters with enemy

fighters but each time Flight Lieutenant Rowland has skilfully out-maneuvred the attackers and afterwards flown his bomber to base. His skill and courage have been worthy of high praise.

Acting Flight Lieutenant Derrick William Cox (124391), Royal Air Force Volunteer Reserve, No. 10 Squadron.

This officer has undertaken many sorties against important targets in Germany and has invariably pressed home his attacks with great vigour. Flight Lieutenant Cox is a most efficient captain whose skill and coolness in action have set a most inspiring example.

Acting Flight Lieutenant Martin Anthony CYBULSKI (Can/J.15807), Royal Canadian Air Force, No. 410 (R.C.A.F.) Squadron.

Flying Officer Harold Herbert LADBROOK (139394), Royal Air Force Volunteer Reserve, No. 410 (R.C.A.F.) Squadron.

As pilot and observer respectively, these officers have taken part in numerous sorties, involving attacks on rail installations, locomotives and various other targets. During a sortie one night in September, 1943, they attacked a Dornier 217 at close range. Following a well directed burst of fire, the enemy aircraft exploded in the air. Flight Lieutenant Cybulski was temporarily blinded by the explosion and the aircraft went into a steep dive. Flying Officer Ladbroke resourcefully regained control, however, and afterwards, Flight Lieutenant Cybulski, who had quickly recovered, flew the aircraft to base. These officers have invariably displayed great skill and tenacity.

Acting Flight Lieutenant Albert George EDWARDS (144620), Royal Air Force Volunteer Reserve, No. 10 Squadron.

This officer has completed a large number of sorties, including attacks on such targets as Essen, Hamburg, Dortmund and Turin. As flight engineer his services have proved extremely valuable and, on more than one occasion, when his aircraft has sustained damage by enemy action, his technical skill has contributed materially to its safe return to base. Flight Lieutenant Edwards has displayed praiseworthy determination and devotion to duty.

Acting Flight Lieutenant John Davidson MITCHNER (Can/J.16799), Royal Canadian Air Force, No. 402 (R.C.A.F.) Squadron.

This officer has completed a large number of sorties, including several very successful attacks on shipping. He is a most determined and able leader, whose confidence in action has proved inspiring. In combat, Flight Lieutenant Mitchner has destroyed 3 enemy aircraft.

Acting Flight Lieutenant John Vaughan PERRINS (115434), Royal Air Force Volunteer Reserve, No. 138 Squadron.

Flight Lieutenant Perrins is an extremely keen and skilful pilot who has taken part in many sorties over enemy territory. His efforts have been featured by great determination and he has obtained notable successes. His coolness and confidence at all times have set an excellent example.

Flying Officer Douglas Stuartson BELL (132618), Royal Air Force Volunteer Reserve, No. 161 Squadron.

Flying Officer Bell is a highly efficient captain and pilot. Throughout his tour he has displayed outstanding keenness and determination, which have inspired all. The successes achieved are a credit to his great skill and fortitude.

Flying Officer Charles John BURNELL (131977), Royal Air Force Volunteer Reserve, No. 10 Squadron.

Flying Officer Burnell is a skilful air bomber whose determined efforts have played a good part in the successes obtained on many sorties which he has undertaken. He has at all times displayed great devotion to duty, while his coolness and confidence in action have set a very fine example.

Flying Officer Robert Michael MUIR (108812), Royal Air Force Volunteer Reserve, No. 264 Squadron.

This officer has executed many sorties during which he has attacked shipping, lines of communication, locomotives and railway buildings with damaging effect. On one occasion in September, 1943, during a sortie over Northern France, his aircraft was damaged by anti-aircraft fire. He flew the aircraft to base, however, and effected a masterly landing. This officer has displayed praiseworthy courage and exceptional keenness.

Flying Officer Thomas Eric TRANTER (133338), Royal Air Force Volunteer Reserve, No. 10 Squadron.

As navigator, this officer has taken part in a large number of attacks on important enemy targets. He has displayed outstanding skill and determination and his faultless work has contributed materially to the successes obtained. Flying Officer Tranter's example of devotion to duty has been most commendable.

Flying Officer Denis Charles Leslie WEBBER (116778), Royal Air Force Volunteer Reserve, No. 120 Squadron.

This officer captained an aircraft which participated in an attack on a U-boat recently. In spite of fierce fire from the U-boat's guns, Flying Officer Webber pressed home his attack and, at the third attempt, straddled the vessel with his depth charges. The submarine blew up, leaving survivors in the water. Flying Officer Webber displayed skill, courage and resolution of a high order.

Pilot Officer Henry Tompson SCOTT (Aus.413289), Royal Australian Air Force, No. 460 (R.A.A.F.) Squadron.

One night in October, 1943, this officer was the pilot of an aircraft detailed to attack Hagen. Whilst over the target area, a heavy shell burst above the aircraft and the windscreens were shattered by fragments of shrapnel. Splinters of glass showered into the cockpit and one piece lodged in Pilot Officer Scott's eye, temporarily blinding him. Nevertheless, he maintained a steady bombing run and attacked the target successfully. Soon afterwards, Pilot Officer Scott fully recovered his sight. He displayed great courage and determination throughout. This officer has undertaken many sorties and these qualities have been a prominent feature of his efforts.

Pilot Officer Walter Leslie TAYLOR (149912), Royal Air Force Volunteer Reserve, No. 10 Squadron.

Pilot Officer Taylor is a wireless operator/air gunner of high merit. He has taken part in very many sorties over enemy territory and his example of determination and devotion to duty in the face of intense enemy opposition has been worthy of great praise. On one occasion he was a member of the crew of an aircraft which crashed and burst into flames shortly after taking off. With commendable coolness and courage, Pilot Officer Taylor rendered valuable help in assisting his comrades to safety.

#### *Distinguished Flying Cross.*

Flight Lieutenant George Johnstone LAIRD (Can/J.4896), Royal Canadian Air Force, No. 427 (R.C.A.F.) Squadron.

#### *Conspicuous Gallantry Medal (Flying).*

Can/R.70142 Sergeant William Harry CARDY, Royal Canadian Air Force, No. 427 (R.C.A.F.) Squadron.

This officer and airman were pilot and flight engineer respectively of an aircraft detailed to attack Kassel one night in October, 1943. During the operation the bomber was hit by a hail of bullets from an enemy fighter. Nevertheless, Flight Lieutenant Laird coolly and skilfully out-maneuvred the enemy aircraft and set course for this country. Two of his crew had been killed, however, and Sergeant Cardy was wounded in the arm and in the eye. In spite of intense suffering, this gallant airman refused to leave his post and executed his normal duties until he finally fainted through loss of blood. Later, when he again recovered consciousness, he attempted to do as much as he could to assist his captain in the home-ward flight. By a superb effort Flight Lieutenant Laird succeeded in reaching base where he effected a safe landing in difficult circumstances. This officer displayed outstanding skill, courage and tenacity, while Sergeant Cardy's exemplary conduct and great fortitude were beyond praise.

#### *Distinguished Flying Cross.*

Acting Squadron Leader Massey Williamson BEVERIDGE (Can/J.15070), Royal Canadian Air Force, No. 418 (R.C.A.F.) Squadron.

#### *Distinguished Flying Medal.*

1445000 Sergeant Bernard Oswald Richard BAYS, Royal Air Force Volunteer Reserve, No. 418 (R.C.A.F.) Squadron.

As pilot and observer respectively, Squadron Leader Beveridge and Sergeant Bays have under-

taken many successful sorties against enemy airfields. During a recent operation they shot down 2 enemy aircraft, one of them after a long pursuit. Their skill and tenacity were highly commendable. Squadron Leader Beveridge is a most efficient flight commander who has set a fine example of devotion to duty, while Sergeant Bays has proved himself to be a most valuable member of aircraft crew.

*Distinguished Flying Medal.*

Aus.408945 Flight Sergeant Gordon Campbell ALLSOP, Royal Australian Air Force, No. 269 Squadron.

In October, 1943, this airman was the pilot of an aircraft engaged on an anti-submarine patrol. During the sortie, a U-boat was sighted on the surface of the sea and about a mile ahead. Flight Sergeant Allsop immediately dived to attack. He was met with intense anti-aircraft fire from the U-boat but, despite this, Flight Sergeant Allsop executed his attack with such accuracy that the vessel sank almost immediately, leaving a large patch of oil and survivors in the water. Flight Sergeant Allsop has invariably displayed skill, courage and devotion to duty of a high order.

Can/R.66602 Flight Sergeant Robert John BURTON, Royal Canadian Air Force, No. 10 Squadron.

As air gunner, Flight Sergeant Burton has participated in very many sorties against well defended targets and has proved himself to be a most dependable member of aircraft crew. One night in September, 1943, Flight Sergeant Burton took part in an attack on Bochum. During the operation, an enemy fighter flew in to attack the bomber from close range. Coolly and skilfully, Flight Sergeant Burton directed his captain in the necessary evading tactics and subsequently, with a well directed burst of fire, he shot the enemy aircraft down. His efforts contributed materially to the success of the operation and the safe return of the bomber.

1338939 Flight Sergeant Bernard BOLSWORTH, Royal Air Force Volunteer Reserve, No. 78 Squadron.

975634 Sergeant George Muirhead GOGGANS, Royal Air Force Volunteer Reserve, No. 78 Squadron.

These airmen were pilot and rear gunner respectively of an aircraft detailed to attack Hanover one night in October, 1943. Nearing the target area the bomber was attacked by a fighter from close range. Sergeant Goggans immediately engaged the attacker, and, with a well directed burst of fire, shot the enemy aircraft down. In the combat, the bomber had sustained damage, but, in spite of this, Flight Sergeant Bolsworth continued his bombing run and executed a successful attack. He displayed exceptional skill and tenacity throughout, while Sergeant Goggans proved himself to be a vigilant and skilful gunner, whose example was highly commendable.

971845 Flight Sergeant Christopher William CHARLTON, Royal Air Force Volunteer Reserve, No. 161 Squadron.

As wireless operator/air gunner this airman has taken part in a very large number of sorties. He has at all times proved himself to be a most reliable member of aircraft crew and his skilful work has contributed materially to the successes obtained. Flight Sergeant Charlton has set a fine example of devotion to duty.

Can/R.69511 Flight Sergeant Duncan Archibald CHISHOLM, Royal Canadian Air Force, No. 10 Squadron.

Flight Sergeant Chisholm is a skilful, cool and determined air gunner. He has undertaken very many sorties and, on more than one occasion in encounters with enemy fighters, he has fought with great zest. Flight Sergeant Chisholm has set a very fine example by his keenness and confidence.

941556 Flight Sergeant Leonard Gordon HALL, Royal Air Force Volunteer Reserve, No. 161 Squadron.

Flight Sergeant Hall is a very efficient wireless operator/air gunner. He has taken part in a very large number of sorties, involving attacks on important and well defended targets. His coolness and resolution in the face of the enemy have proved inspiring.

52582 Sergeant Lewis Edward HOPKINS, Royal Air Force, No. 10 Squadron.

As flight engineer, Sergeant Hopkins has participated in very many sorties against important targets and throughout has displayed great zeal and resolution. He is a highly efficient engineer, whose exemplary conduct has been worthy of great praise.

1313405 Sergeant Eric Edwin WAKEFORD, Royal Air Force Volunteer Reserve, No. 10 Squadron.

This airman is a highly skilled wireless operator/air gunner and, throughout his tour of operations, has displayed great determination and devotion to duty. Sergeant Wakeford has rendered excellent service and his efforts have proved a valuable contribution towards the success of many of the sorties in which he has taken part.
