Flying Officer Roy Howard MITCHELL (133678), Royal Air Force Volunteer Reserve, No. 621 Squadron.

Distinguished Flying Medal.

1080597 Sergeant Walter Raymond STEVENSON, Royal Air Force Volunteer Reserve, No. 621 Squadron.

This officer and airman were pilot and wireless operator (air) respectively of an aircraft which successfully attacked a U-boat on a recent occasion. Sergeant Stevenson first sighted the vessel fully surfaced some miles distant and promptly warned his pilot who approached to the attack with great skill. In the run in Sergeant Stevenson used his guns to good effect and, as the U-boat attempted to submerge, Flying Officer Mitchell straddled it with his depth charges, forcing it to the surface. This officer and airman displayed praiseworthy skill and determination throughout.
