The KING has been graciously pleased to approve the following awards in recognition of gallantry displayed in flying operations against the enemy:—

Bar to Distinguished Flying Cross.

Acting Squadron Leader Eric Gordon BARWELL, D.F.C. (77454), R.A.F.V.R., 125 Sqn.

This officer has completed a very large number of sorties and his example of keenness, determination and devotion to duty has been worthy of the highest praise. He is a most able flight commander whose untiring efforts have been reflected in the operational efficiency of the formation

he commands. Squadron Leader Barwell has destroyed 6 enemy aircraft, 2 of them at night. Flying Officer Colin Gowans FINLAYSON, D.F.C. (Can/J.13956), R.C.A.F., 418 (R.C.A.F.) Sqn.

This officer continues to display the highest qualities of skill, bravery and devotion to duty. As observer he has taken part in a large number of sorties, many of them of a difficult and dangerous nature. On one occasion, in May, 1944, he took part in a sortie far into enemy territory during which he assisted in the destruction of 5 enemy aircraft. He has proved himself to be a most valuable member of the squadron.

Distinguished Flying Cross.

Squadron Leader Ronald Walter WALLENS (70708), R.A.F.O., 277 Sqn.

In the early phases of the war, Squadron Leader Wallens took part in a large number of sorties during which he destroyed at least 4 enemy aircraft. In a combat in September, 1940, he was wounded in the leg by a cannon shell. Since his return to operational duties he has undertaken many air/sea rescue sorties and has been responsible for saving a number of personnel from the sea. He has set a splendid example of gallantry and devotion to duty.

Flight Lieutenant Basil CHAMPNEYS (116920), R.A.F.V.R., 208 Sqn.

This officer has completed very many reconnaissances, often in the face of heavy anti-aircraft opposition and in adverse weather. In June, 1944, at a critical stage in the advance from Anzio to Highway 6, Flight Lieutenant Champneys executed a reconnaissance of the Vai montone defence line, obtaining information which proved invaluable to the ground forces. This officer has displayed skill, gallantry and determination of a high order.

Flight Lieutenant Robert Lloyd Rees DAVIES (63457), R.A.F.V.R., 25 Sqn.

This officer has completed a notable tour during which he has attacked many enemy airfields and railway communications with much success. He is a highly skilled and courageous pilot whose example has been inspiring. He has destroyed 3 enemy aircraft at night, 2 of them in one sortie.

Flight Lieutenant Clarence Muri JASPER (Can/J.10611), R.C.A.F., 418 (R.C.A.F.) Sqn.

This officer is a most skilful and resolute pilot, whose determination to engage the enemy has always been evident. He has completed many sorties and has destroyed 3 enemy aircraft in the air and others on the ground.

Flight Lieutenant Oscar Archibald Joseph MARTIN (Can/J.7792), R.C.A.F., 418 (R.C.A.F.) Sqn.

As observer, Flight Lieutenant Martin has participated in many sorties both by day and night.

He is a highly skilled and gallant member of aircraft crew, whose example has been most commendable. He has assisted in the destruction of 4 enemy aircraft.

Flight Lieutenant Kevin Thomas Anthony O'SULLIVAN (127032), R.A.F.V.R., 125 Sqn.

Flight Lieutenant O'Sullivan has undertaken very many sorties and has displayed a high standard of skill and keenness throughout. He is a most determined fighter and has destroyed 5 enemy aircraft, 4 of them at night.

Flight Lieutenant Peter Foy PERRY (120658), R.A.F.V.R., 208 Sqn.

This officer has completed a large number of reconnaissances and has displayed a high standard of leadership, skill and gallantry. On one occasion, when reconnoitring a heavily defended area his aircraft was hit by an anti-aircraft shell, causing damage to the elevator and the rudder, which became almost useless. In spite of this, Flight Lieutenant Perry completed his task and afterwards flew the damaged aircraft to base. His determination on this occasion was typical of that which he has shown throughout his tour.

Flight Lieutenant Myles Chapman SCARGILL (127501), R.A.F.V.R., 236 Sqn.

This officer has completed a large number of sorties, including numerous successful attacks on shipping. He has invariably displayed a high degree of courage, skill and resolution, qualities which were amply demonstrated in a recent attack on an enemy convoy. During the engagement his aircraft was hit by anti-aircraft fire which caused a rocket projectile to explode beneath the wing. In spite of this, Flight Lieutenant Scargill pressed home his attack with great determination, obtaining hits on his target. He has set a fine example to all.

Flying Officer Arthur Norman CROOKES (135428), R.A.F.V.R., 488 (N.Z.) Sqn.

As observer, Flying Officer Crookes has taken part in a large number of sorties and has displayed commendable courage and resource. He has assisted in the destruction of 5 enemy aircraft, successes which are an excellent tribute to his high skill and excellent co-operation.

Warrant Officer William Louis BUTLER (N.Z.40602), R.N.Z.A.F., 277 Sqn.

Warrant Officer Butler has completed a very large number of sorties, including very many air/sea rescue missions on which he has assisted in saving a goodly number of personnel from the sea. He has displayed a high standard of gallantry and devotion to duty and his record is worthy of the greatest praise.
