PRESENT.

The KING's Most Excellent Majesty in Council.

WHEREAS the Ecclesiastical Commissioners for Majesty in Council a Scheme bearing date the 20th day of July, 1944, in the words and figures following, that is to say:

"We, the Ecclesiastical Commissioners for England, acting in pursuance of the New Parishes

Measure, 1943, have prepared and now humbly lay before Your Majesty in Council the following Scheme for altering the boundaries of the parish of Stanley, the parish of St. Andrew, Wakefield, the parish of St. Mary, Altofts, and the parish of St. John, Wakefield, all in the diocese of Wakefield:
"Whereas we are satisfied that it is desirable that

the boundaries of the said parishes should be altered in the manner hereinafter mentioned:

And whereas the Bishop of the diocese consents

And whereas the Bisnop of the diocese consents to the proposed arrangements (in testimony whereof he has signed this Scheme):

"Now, therefore, we, the said Ecclesiastical Commissioners for England, humbly recommend and propose that from and after the day of the date of the publication in the London Gazette of any Order of Your Majesty in Council ratifying this Scheme the boundaries of the said parish of Stanley, the said parish of St. Andrew, Wakefield, the said parish of St. Mary, Altofts, and the said parish of St. John, Wakefield, shall be altered in the manner described in the Schedule and delineated on the map annexed to this Scheme.

THE SCHEDULE to which the foregoing Scheme

has reference:

"The territory (shown by the blue colour on the map) to be annexed to the parish of St. Andrew, Wakefield, in the said county and diocese, compris-

"All that portion of the said parish of Stanley which is bounded upon the south-east and upon the south by the said parish of St. Andrew, Wakefield, and upon the remaining sides by an imaginary line commencing upon the boundary which divides the said parish of St. Andrew, Wakefield, from the said parish of St. John, Wakefield, at the junction of Eastmoor Road and Long Causeway and extending thence northwards along the middle of Long Causeway for a distance of 21 chains or thereabouts to its junction with the road running from Long Causeway to North Avenue and extending thence westward along the middle of such road for a distance of 8 chains or thereabouts to its junction with North Avenue and with the roadway forming the western boundary of Pinders Fields and extending thence northward along the middle of such roadway for a distance of 14½ chains or thereabouts to its junction with the roadway forming the northern boundary of Pinders Fields way forming the northern boundary of Pinders Fields

and extending thence eastwards along the south side of the said roadway for a distance of 13½ chains or thereabouts to its eastern end and extending thence southward along the western side of Ouchthorpe Lane for a distance of I chain or thereabouts to a point opposite to the southern side of Barr Lane and extending thence eastward to and along the southern side of Barr Lane for a distance of 15 chains or thereabouts to its eastern end and extending thence southward along the western side of Abertord Road for a distance of 3½ chains or thereabouts to a point opposite to the middle of the roadway or footpath leading past St. Swithin's Cottage and extending thence generally eastward along the said roadway or footpath for a distance of 42½ chains or thereabouts to its junction with the roadway or footpath leading to Balk Lane upon the boundary which divides the said parish of Stanley from the said parish of St. Andrew, Wakefield.

"The territory (shown respectively by the green and mauve colours on the map) to be annexed to the said parish of Stanley in the said county and diocese comprising:—

"(1) All that portion of the said parish of St. Andrew, Wakefield, which is bounded upon the north-east by the said parish of St. Mary, Altofts, upon the west by the said parish of Stanley, and upon the south by an imaginary line commencing upon the boundary which divides the said parish of Stanley, from the said parish of St. Andrew, Wakefield, at a point in the middle of the Swing-bridge near the south-eastern end of Ward Lane, over the Aire and Calder Navigation New Cut, and extending thence south-eastward to and eastward along the roadway running eastward from the bridge to its eastern end and in a straight line in continuato its eastern end and in a straight line in continua-

to its eastern end and in a straight line in continuation thereof for a distance in all of 38½ chains or thereabouts to the boundary which divides the said parish of St. Andrew, Wakefield, from the said parish of St. Mary, Altofts.

"(2) All that portion of the said parish of St. Mary, Altofts, which is bounded upon the south-west by the said parish of Stanley and upon the remaining sides that is to say upon the north-west and upon the east by an imaginary line commencing upon the boundary which divides the said parish of Stanley from the said parish of St. Mary, Altofts, at a point in the middle of the bridge which carries Birkwood Road over the River Calder and extending
