In pursuance of Section 1 of the Rules Publication Act, 1893, notice is hereby given that the Minister of Labour and National Service proposes, at the expiration of 40 days from the publication of this notice, to make Regulations under Sub-Section 2 of Section 71 of the Factories Act, 1937, to continue in operation until 31st December, 1946, the Weekly Hours of Young Persons under Sixteen in Factories (Various Textile and Allied Industries) Regulations, 1940, in so far as such Regulations authorise the employment of young persons who have attained the age of fifteen for 48 working hours a week in woollen or worsted factories and in the operations known as legging and stripping in the finishing of hosiery.
