

These daring efforts enabled the Company to increase the momentum of its attack and so relieve pressure on another Company which was attacking from another direction.

The outstanding gallantry of Private Starceвич in carrying out these attacks single-handed with complete disregard of his own personal safety resulted in the decisive success of the action.
