GEORGE THE SIXTH, by the Grace of God, of Great Britain, Ireland and the British Dominions beyond the Seas KING, Defender of the Faith, Emperor of India, to all to whom these Presents shall come,

Greeting!

Whereas by Warrant under Our Royal Sign Manual dated the 22nd June, 1940, revised Rules were established for the governance of a Decoration designated and styled "The Special Constabulary Long Service Medal."

And whereas We are desirous of clarifying the meaning of certain words in the said Warrant, We are graciously pleased to make, ordain and establish the following Rule for the governance of the said Decoration:—

It is ordained that the words "during the present war" in the proviso to Rule III therein contained shall be interpreted and understood to mean "during the period beginning with the 3rd September, 1939, and ending with the 31st December, 1945."

Given at Our Court at Saint James's the Twenty-seventh day of December, 1945; in the Tenth Year of Our Reign.
