

WAGES COUNCILS ACT, 1945.

CUTLERY WAGES COUNCIL (GREAT BRITAIN).

The Cutlery Wages Council (Great Britain) hereby gives notice of its intention to submit to the Minister of Labour and National Service proposals for (1) the revocation of the Cutlery Wages Council (Great Britain) Wages Regulation Order, 1945 (S.R. & O. 1945, No. 1321) and for the fixing of specified statutory minimum remuneration in substitution for the statutory minimum remuneration at present in operation and (2) for the amendment of Order C.T. (23) dated 29th March, 1940, and of Order C.T. (20) dated 1st October, 1941, which deal with holidays with pay.

The Wages Council will consider any written representations with respect to the above mentioned proposals which may be sent to it within fourteen days from 13th August, 1946. BOROUGH OF TAUNTON.

SPECIAL ENACTMENTS (EXTENSION OF TIME) ACT, 1940.

Whereas the Mayor, Aldermen and Burgesses of the Borough of Taunton (hereinafter called "the Corporation") made application to the Minister of Health (hereinafter called "the Minister") for an Order under the Special Enactments (Extension of Time) Act, 1940 (hereinafter called "the Act of 1940") to extend by three years the time limited by section 17 of the Taunton Corporation Act, 1937, for the completion of the waterworks numbered 1, 2 and 4 as described in subsection (1) of section 15 of that Act;

And whereas the Minister by the Taunton (Extension of Time) Order, 1943, extended the said time by three years, that is to say until the third day of August, 1946;

And whereas the Corporation have made application to the Minister for an Order under the Act of 1940 to extend the time as now limited by a further period of three years, that is to say until the third day of August, 1949;

Notice is hereby given that the Minister will consider any objection or representation made to him in writing before the 2nd day of September, 1946, by any person or body interested in the said application. Any such objection or representation should be addressed to the Secretary, Ministry of Health, Whitehall, London, S.W.1, and a copy of it should at the same time be sent to the Town Clerk, Municipal Buildings, Taunton, Somerset.
