RULES PUBLICATION ACT, 1893.

ROAD TRAFFIC ACT, 1930.

Notice is hereby given under the Rules Publication Act, 1893, that it is proposed by the Minister of Transport, after the expiration of at least 40 days from this date, in exercise of the powers conferred upon him by the Road Traffic Act, 1930, and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, to make Regulations to be entitled the Public Service Vehicles (Conditions of Fitness) (Amendment) (No.) Regulations, 1946, to facilitate the construction of double-deck public service vehicles without projection of the upper deck gangway into the driver's compartment; and in the case of vehicles first registered on or after 1st January, 1947, to prohibit such projection.

RIVER WELAND CATCHMENT BOARD.

Addition of Certain Lands in the Parish of Deeping St. James to the Deeping Fen Spalding, and Pinchbeck Internal Drainage District.

or that any requirement of the Act has not been complied with he may, within six weeks after the publication of this notice, make an application for the purpose to the High Court and if any such application is duly made, the Court, if satisfied that the Order is not within the powers of the Act, or that the interests of the applicant have been substantially prejudiced by any requirements of the Act not having been complied with, may quash the Order either generally or in so far as it affects the applicant.
