SUMMARY.

The foregoing list contains 421 cases, viz. . . . 5 American, 67 Austrian, 17 Czechoslovak, 1 Danish, 7 Dutch, 11 French, 218 German, 5 Greek, 12 Hungarian, 15 Italian, 15 No Nationality, 10 Polish, 2 Portuguese, 4 Rumanian, 16 Russian, 1 Swedish, and 15 other Nationalities. Of these, 36 (including 3 American, 2 Czechoslovak, 4 Dutch, 2 French, 10 German, 3 Greek, 2 Hungarian, 6 Italian, 1 Polish, 1 Roumanian, 2 Russian), relate to women of British origin.
