WHEREAS by Our Warrant dated 5th February, 1941, we were pleased to make provision for the establishment and organisation of a corps to be entitled the Air Training Corps and other matters and things relating thereto:

And Whereas We deem it expedient to make further provision regarding the Air Training Corps:

Our Will and Pleasure is that notwithstanding anything contained in Our Warrant dated 5th February, 1941, as subsequently amended, the Regulations in the schedule to this Our Warrant shall be regulations governing the Air Training Corps and shall be the sole and standing authority on the matters whereof they treat.

Given at Our Court at St. James's this 23rd day of June, 1947, in the eleventh year of Our Reign.
