##### TRUNK ROADS ACT, 1946.

The Minister of Transport hereby gives notice that he proposes to make an Order under section 4 of the Trunk Roads Act, 1946, the effect of which will be:—

(a) to provide for the construction by the Minister of a new road from a point on Station Road approximately 46 yards from its junction with the Fishguard-Aberystwyth-Dolgelly-Caernarvon-Bangor (Menai Suspension Bridge) Trunk Road at Trawsfynydd in the County of Merioneth to a point on the said Trunk Road approximately 15 yards south-west of the said junction;

(b) to provide for the stopping up entirely of the existing junction between Station Road and the said Trunk Road when the new road is completed;

(c) that the Merioneth County Council will become the highway authority for the new road on the first day of April next after the date on which notice is given by the Minister to the Council that the new road is opened for through traffic.

#### MINISTRY OF TRANSPORT.

##### TRUNK ROADS ACT, 1946.

The Minister of Transport hereby gives notice that he proposes to make an Order under section 4 of the Trunk Roads Act, 1946, the effect of which will be:—

(a) to provide for the construction by the Minister of new roads near Llanbeder and Penhow in the County of Monmouth:

(i) from a point on the road leading to Catsash approximately 70 yards north-west of its junction with the London-Fishguard Trunk Road at Llanbeder to a point on the said Trunk Road approximately 380 yards north-east of the said junction;

(ii) from a point on the road leading to Llandeud Mill approximately 80 yards south-east of its junction with the said Trunk Road at Llanbeder to a point on the said Trunk Road approximately 80 yards north-east of the said junction;

(iii) from a point on the road leading to Hendrew Farm approximately 70 yards north of its junction with the said Trunk Road near Llanbeder to a point on the said Trunk Road approximately 30 yards south-west of the said junction;

(iv) from a point on the road leading to Parc-Seymour approximately 50 yards north-west of its junction with the said Trunk Road at Penhow to a point on the said Trunk Road approximately 30 yards west of the said junction;

(v) from a point leading to Magor approximately 10 yards south-west of its junction with the said Trunk Road near Penhow to a point on the said Trunk Road approximately 30 yards west of the said junction;

(vi) from a point on the road leading to Penyworldad approximately 80 yards north of its junction with the said Trunk Road at Penhow to a point on the said Trunk Road approximately 20 yards north-west of the said junction;

(b) to provide for the stopping up entirely of the existing junctions between the said Trunk Road and the roads leading to Catsash, Llandeud Mill, Hendrew Farm, Parc-Seymour and Penyworldad aforesaid respectively when the respective new roads have been completed;

(c) that the Monmouthshire County Council will become the highway authority for the new roads on the first day of April next after the date on which notice is given by the Minister to the Council that the new roads are opened for through traffic.
