The Lords Commissioners of His Majesty's Treasury hereby give notice that They have made an Order under Sections 1 and 19 of the Import Duties Act, 1932, Section 10 of the Finance Act, 1934, and Section 1 of the Import Duties (Emergency Provisions) Act, 1939, viz.:—

The Import Duties (Exemptions) (No. 4) Order, 1947, relating to the exemption from general ad valorem duty on siloxanes, whether polymerised or not, and, if containing 50 per cent. or more by weight of siloxanes-silastics; and siloxane compounds, greases, resins and fluids.
