

for the purposes of Part I. of the Town and Country Planning Act, 1944, any land for the time being held by them for other purposes, being land to which Section 14 (2) applies, that is to say, land which is or forms part of, a common, open space or fuel or field garden allotment (including any such land which is specially regulated by any enactment whether public general or local or private), other than land being Green Belt land as defined in the Green Belt (London and Home Counties) Act, 1938, provided that such Order shall be subject to special Parliamentary procedure except where the Minister of Town and Country Planning is satisfied that there has been or will be given in exchange for such land other land not being less in area, and being equally advantageous to the persons, if any, entitled to rights of common or other rights, and to the public, and that the land given in exchange has been or will be vested in the persons in whom the land appropriated was vested, and subject to the like rights, trusts and incidents as attached to the land appropriated, and certifies accordingly.

And whereas the City of Plymouth (Stonehouse) Appropriation Order, 1946, authorises the appropriation of approximately .757 acre of land forming an open space at Stonehouse in the City of Plymouth.

And whereas certain land will be given in exchange for such land.

And whereas public notice has been given by the Minister of his intention to give a certificate under the said Section 14 as respects the proposed exchange, and an opportunity has been afforded to all persons interested to make representations and objections in relation thereto to the Minister.

Notice is hereby given that the Minister of Town and Country Planning, in pursuance of the powers enabling him in that behalf has certified that the

land that will be given in exchange for the said land forming an open space is not less in area and is equally advantageous to the persons entitled to rights of common or other rights, and to the public, and that the land to be given in exchange will be vested in the persons in whom the land appropriated was vested, and will be subject to the like rights, trusts and incidents as attached to the land appropriated.

A Map showing the area of the said land to be given in exchange for the land forming an open space may be inspected at the Town Clerk's Office, Pounds House, Peverell, Plymouth, without payment of fee during usual office hours.
