EXPLANATORY NOTE

These Regulations provide for the manner in which evidence is to be given for the purposes of sickness benefit and maternity benefit, and contain rules as to the form in which and the times at which certificates should be furnished when claiming those benefits

MINISTRY OF TRANSPORT.

TRUNK ROADS ACT, 1946

The Minister of Transport hereby gives notice that he proposes to make an Order under section 4 of the Trunk Roads Act, 1946, the effect of which will be:

(a) To provide for the construction by the Minister of new roads

(i) from points on the Winchester-Preston Trunk Road approximately 200 yards north-west and 310 yards south-east respectively of Cliffe-lane Aqueduct at Grappenhall in the County of Chester each for a distance of approximately 35 yards in a general westerly direction, to the new trunk road to be constructed by the Minister at Grappenhall aforesaid to supersede a length of the existing Trunk Road;

(ii) from a point on Bellhouse Lane approximately 65 yards south-west of its junction with the existing Trunk Road for a distance of approximately 50 yards in a north-easterly direction to a point on the new trunk road approximately 35 yards south-east of the said junction;

(b) to provide for the stopping up entirely of the junctions between the new trunk road and the existing Trunk Road and between Bellhouse Lane and the new trunk road when the respective new roads are completed,

(c) that the Council of the County of Chester will become the highway authority for the new roads on the first day of April next after the date on which notice is given by the Minister to the Council that the new roads are opened for through traffic.
