Civil Service Commission

The Civil Service Commissioners hereby give notice,
in pursuance of Clause 13 of the General Regulations
made under the Order in Council of the 22nd July,
1920 that, with the approval of the Lords Com-
missioners of His Majesty's Treasury, they have
prescribed that officers transferred to situations under
the Board of Inland Revenue from permanent em-
ployment under Local Authorities or under the
Railway Assessment Authority, in consequence of
the transfer of functions to the Crown, shall be
exempted from payment of any fee in respect of
the issue of Certificates of Qualification in their
favour
