*The London—Edinburgh—Thurso Trunk Road (Scotch Corner Junction Improvements) Order, 1948.*

**MINISTRY OF TRANSPORT.****TRUNK ROADS ACT, 1946.**

The Minister of Transport hereby gives notice that he proposes to make an Order under section 4 of the Trunk Roads Act, 1946, the effect of which will be:—

(a) to provide for the improvement of the junction between the Swansea-Manchester Trunk Road and the road leading to Bishops Castle at Garthmyl in the County of Montgomery by realigning the said road from a point approximately 90 yards south-east of its junction with the said Trunk Road to the junction;
