THE HATFIELD NEW TOWN (DESIGNATION)
ORDER, 1948.

Notice is hereby given that the Minister of Town and Country Planning in pursuance of the powers vested in him by Section 1 of the New Towns Act, 1946, on the 20th day of May, 1948, made an Order designating as the site of a proposed new town an area of land comprising approximately 2,340 acres situate in the Rural District of Hatfield and the Urban District of Welwyn Garden City in the County of Hertfordshire, which land is shown on the map annexed to the Order.

This area is the area which was shown on the map annexed to the Draft Hatfield New Town (Designation) Order, 1948, which was deposited for inspection at the offices of the Hatfield Rural District Council, No. 16, St. Albans Road, Hatfield, on or about the ninth day of January, 1948, and with respect to which a public local inquiry was held at The Cherry Tree, Welwyn Garden City, on the 22nd and 23rd days of March, 1948.

THE WELWYN GARDEN CITY NEW TOWN
(DESIGNATION) ORDER, 1948.

Notice is hereby given that the Minister of Town and Country Planning in pursuance of the powers vested in him by Section 1 of the New Towns Act, 1946, on the 20th day of May, 1948, made an Order designating as the site of a proposed new town an area of land comprising approximately 4,230 acres situate in the Urban District of Welwyn Garden City, the Rural District of Welwyn, the Rural District of Hatfield and the Rural District of Hertford in the County of Hertfordshire, which land is shown in the map annexed to the Order.

The area thus designated is some 29 acres less in extent than the area which was shown on the map annexed to the Draft Welwyn New Town (Designation) Order, 1948, which was deposited for inspection at the offices of the Welwyn Garden City Urban District Council on or about the ninth day of January, 1948, and with respect to which a public local inquiry was held at The Cherry Tree, Welwyn Garden City, on the 22nd and 23rd days of March, 1948. This reduction in the size of the area has been effected by the exclusion of about 29 acres of land west of the Great North Road, near Lemsford village.
