## SECTION 7.

*Revocation of Certificates of Naturalization.*

The Secretary of State has revoked the following certificate—  
Marcel Georges Armand de RAPPARD: Country of origin, Belgium Certificate No A 72627 (Canadian) Granted on the 25th September, 1930. Revoked on the 16th June, 1948. Reason: Disaffection and disloyalty (Section 7 (1)), also unlawfully communicating with the enemy (Section 7 (2) (a)) de RAPPARD was resident at 49, Eton Avenue, London, N.W.3.

The Secretary of State has also directed that Elizabeth de RAPPARD, the wife of the said Marcel Georges Armand de RAPPARD, and Fernando de RAPPARD, his son, being a minor, shall cease to be British subjects
