SUPPLEMENTARY RECONSTRUCTION COMPETITION FOR THE APPOINTMENT OF ASSISTANT INSPECTORS OF MINES AND QUARRIES (MALE) UNDER THE MINISTRY OF FUEL AND POWER

1 Every candidate must have been born on or after 2nd August, 1905, and on or before 2nd August, 1920

2 Candidates must be British subjects They must also satisfy one of the following conditions:—

(a) If natural-born British subjects, they must either

(i) have at least one parent who is or was at death a British subject, or

(ii) have resided in His Majesty's dominions and/or been employed elsewhere in the service of the Crown for at least five years out of the last eight years preceding the date of their appointment;

(b) If naturalised British subjects, they must have resided in His Majesty's dominions and/or been employed elsewhere in the service of the Crown for at least five years out of the last eight years preceding the date of their appointment

(c) If not qualified under (a) or (b) of this paragraph they must satisfy the Commissioners that they are so closely connected with His Majesty's dominions either by ancestry, upbringing or residence, or by reason of national service, that an exception may properly be made in their favour.

3. Every candidate (a) must hold a First-Class Certificate of Competency under the Coal Mines Act, 1911, and (b) must, within five years previous to his application, have been employed for not less than two years as manager or under-manager of a coal mine, or in some other responsible capacity requiring regular attendance underground in a coal mine. A varied experience is desirable

Practical knowledge and experience of Metalliferous Mining and Quarrying will also be taken into consideration.

4. Every candidate must satisfy the Commissioners as to his health and character

5 No person who is undergoing a course of study with the aid of a grant from public funds shall be eligible to compete before the completion of the course, unless he has previously obtained permission to do so from the authority which administers the grant

6 Every candidate must apply on the appropriate form within the time and in the manner of which notice is given by the Commissioners.

7 The Commissioners may summon to appear before a Selection Board all who are found to be *prima facie* eligible, or may, if they see fit, summon only those whose qualifications and experience are considered to be specially suitable. The Board will take into consideration the candidate's record of experience and education, with due regard to loss of opportunity and to the loss of professional knowledge of those who have served in the Forces, any recommendation from persons named by the candidates as having direct knowledge of their work in the past, and the personal qualities of the candidates as shown at the interview, and on their estimation of all the above facts they will frame their recommendations. The decision of the Commissioners will be final

8 Persons upon whose training for the occupation of teacher public money has been spent cannot be appointed until the consent of the appropriate central education authority (e.g., the Ministry of Education, the Scottish Education Department, the Ministry of Education for Northern Ireland) has been notified to the Commissioners

9 Any attempt on the part of candidates to enlist support for their applications through Members of Parliament or other influential persons, except as referees to be named by them in their Application Forms, will disqualify them for appointment. The Interviewing Board will disregard spontaneous recommendations from persons who are not personally acquainted with the candidate's work, whether at school, at the University, in the Forces, or otherwise

10 A successful candidate shall be required to pay a fee of £1 before the issue of a certificate of qualification for appointment
