TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING ACT, 1944

City of Plymouth (Reconstruction Areas Nos 6 and 7: Devonport) Declaratory Order, 1948

NOTICE is hereby given that the Minister of Town and Country Planning in pursuance of the powers vested in him by Section 1 of the Town and Country Planning Act, 1944, on the eighth day of September, 1948, made an Order declaring the land situate at Plymouth and described in the Schedule hereto, which land is shown coloured red on the map referred to in the Order, to be subject to compulsory purchase for the purpose of dealing with war damage

A copy of the Order and of the map have been deposited at the Town Clerk's Office, Pounds House, Peverell, Plymouth, and will be open for inspection by all persons interested without payment of fee during usual office hours
