## Civil Service Commission.

The Civil Service Commissioners hereby give notice that, with the approval of the Lords Commissioners of H M. Treasury, the following amendment has been made in the undermentioned Regulations dated the 2nd July 1948 and published in the London Gazette of the same date, viz:—

RECRUITMENT UNDER NORMAL REGULATIONS TO THE EXECUTIVE CLASS (AND CORRESPONDING DEPARTMENTAL CLASSES) OF THE HOME CIVIL SERVICE AND TO EXECUTIVE POSTS IN BRANCH B OF THE FOREIGN SERVICE

## Regulation 1

Add "But candidates who have served in any established post to which they were admitted with the Certificate of the Civil Service Commissioners, or who have served on established conditions except for sick leave and pension in a post to which such a Certificate would normally apply, may deduct from their actual age any time not exceeding two years which they may have spent on such service before 1st September 1948"

## WATER ACT, 1945

Notice is hereby given that the Minister of Health is about to make an order under section 9 (2) of the Water Act, 1945, providing for (1) the setting up of a new Joint Water Board to be known as the Isle of Wight Water Board, and (2) the compulsory transfer to the Board of all statutory water undertakings on the Island.

The county and county districts wholly affected by the order are the county of the Isle of Wight, the boroughs of Newport and Ryde, the urban districts of Cowes, Sandown-Shanklin, and Ventnor, and the rural district of Isle of Wight.
