

NEW TOWNS ACT, 1946.

BASILDON NEW TOWN (DESIGNATION) ORDER, 1949.

Notice is hereby given that the Minister of Town and Country Planning in pursuance of the powers vested in him by Section 1 of the New Towns Act, 1946, on the 4th day of January, 1949, made an Order designating as the site of a proposed New Town an area of land comprising approximately 7,834 acres situate in the Urban Districts of Billericay and Thurrock in the County of Essex, which land is shown on the map annexed to the Order.

2. The area thus designated is some 16 acres less in extent than the area which was shown on the map annexed to the draft Basildon New Town (Designation) Order, 1948, which was deposited for inspection at the Council Rates Office, Laindon, and the Post Office, Pitsea, and the Offices of the Billericay and Thurrock Urban District Councils on or about the 30th day of July, 1948, and with respect to which a Public Local Inquiry was held at the Memorial Hall, Laindon, Essex, on the 7th day of October, 1948. This reduction in the size of the area has been effected by the exclusion of parts of the upper reaches of Pitsea and Vange Creeks.

3. In compliance with the provisions of Paragraph 5 of the First Schedule to the Act, a copy of the Order and of the map have been deposited at the Council Rates Office, High Road, Laindon, and may be inspected without payment of fee on weekdays (including Saturdays) between the hours of 10 a.m. and 12 noon and 2 p.m. and 5 p.m. and at the Post Office, The Broadway, High Road, Pitsea, between 9 a.m. and 6 p.m. on weekdays except Thursdays and between 9 a.m. and 1 p.m. on Thursdays. A copy of the Order and of the map have also been deposited at the Offices of the Billericay Urban District Council, 98, High Street, Billericay where they will be open for inspection, without payment of fee, between the hours of 9 a.m. and 1 p.m. and between 2 p.m. and 4.30 p.m. on weekdays except Saturdays and between 9 a.m. and 11.30 a.m. on Saturdays; at the Thurrock Urban District Council Offices, Whitehall Lane, Grays, between the hours of 9 a.m. and 5 p.m. on weekdays except Saturdays and between 9 a.m. and 12 noon on Saturdays; and at the Ministry of Town and Country Planning, No. 32, St. James's Square, London, S.W.1, where they may be inspected between the hours of 9.30 a.m. and 5 p.m. on weekdays except Saturdays and between 9.30 a.m. and 12 noon on Saturdays.

EXTINGUISHMENT OF PUBLIC RIGHTS OF WAY.

County Borough of West Ham.

Notice is hereby given that the Minister of Town and Country Planning, in exercise of the powers conferred upon him by Section 23 of the Town and Country Planning Act, 1944, as amended by the Town and Country Planning Act, 1947, has prepared in draft and proposes to make an Order extinguishing the public rights of way over the following highways:—

Elphick Street (part); Agate Street (part); Albany Road (part).

A copy of the draft Order and of a map showing the rights of way proposed to be extinguished may be inspected at the Town Clerk's Department (General Office) West Ham Town Hall, E.15, without payment of fee, between the hours of 9 a.m. and 4.30 p.m. (Mondays to Fridays) and 9 a.m. and 11.30 a.m. (Saturdays).

Any objection to this proposal must be made in writing and addressed to the Minister of Town and Country Planning, 32 St. James's Square, London, S.W.1, before the 7th day of April, 1949.

The Minister is not, in all cases, required to cause a local inquiry to be held. It is important, therefore, that an objection should include a full statement in writing of the grounds on which the objection is made as the objector may have no further opportunity to make such a statement.
