*Street Trading—Designation of Streets.*

NOTICE is hereby given that pursuant to Section 16 of the above mentioned Act, the Holborn Borough Council have by Resolution passed at their meeting on the 29th June 1949, excluded fried fish and chips from the class or classes of articles or things which can be sold or offered or exposed for sale at the under mentioned sites:

**STREET.**

Farringdon Road, east side of carriageway next to curb; from Charterhouse Street for 180 feet northwards.

Charterhouse Street, north side of carriageway next to curb; from building line of east side of Farringdon Road for 24 feet eastwards.

Leather Lane, east and west sides of carriageway next to curb; from Greville Street to Clerkenwell Road.

Earlham Street, north and south sides of carriageway next to curb; from Seven Dials to Shaftesbury Avenue.

New North Street, east side of carriageway next to curb; from building line on north side of Theobalds Road for 100 feet northwards.

John Street, east side of carriageway next to curb; commencing at a distance of 40 feet from building line on north side of Theobalds Road, for a distance of 7 feet northwards.

Neal Street, west side of carriageway next to curb; on corner of Earlham Street and Shelton Street outside International Correspondence School at No. 31 Neal Street, for a distance of 7 feet.
