#### WAGES COUNCILS ACTS, 1945 TO 1948.

##### THE ROPE, TWINE AND NET WAGES COUNCIL (GREAT BRITAIN).

The Rope, Twine and Net Wages Council (Great Britain) hereby gives notice of its intention to submit to the Minister of Labour and National Service proposals for the amendment of the Rope, Twine and Net Wages Council (Great Britain) Wages Regulation (Holidays) Order, 1946 (Order R.(84)) as amended by the Rope, Twine and Net Wages Council (Great Britain) Wages Regulation (No. 2) Order, 1948 (Order R.(93)).

#### PETROLEUM (PRODUCTION) ACT, 1934.

The Minister of Fuel and Power hereby gives notice that he has renewed, for a term of twelve months, twelve prospecting licences granted under the Petroleum (Production) Act, 1934, and Petroleum (Production) Regulations, 1935, to the D'Arcy Exploration Company Ltd., Britannic House, Finsbury Circus, London, E.C.2.
