CAB STANDINGS.

Notice is hereby given that in pursuance of Section 4 of the London Hackney Carriages Act, 1850, the Commissioner of Police of the Metropolis has issued Orders dated 10th November, 1949, appointing the following cab standings:—

A standing for two hackney carriages at Bowes Road, New Southgate, N.;

A standing for six hackney carriages at Sardinia Street, W.C.;

A standing for eight hackney carriages at Highfield Avenue, Golders Green, N.W.;

A standing for six hackney carriages at Broadway, Stratford, E.

He has also made Regulations regarding these standings.
