RIVER GREAT OUSE CATCHMENT BOARD.

Feldale Internal Drainage District.

Whittlesey and Kingsland Internal Drainage District.

Notice is hereby given that the Minister of Agriculture and Fisheries has now confirmed the Order made on the 2nd August, 1950, in relation to the Scheme prepared by the River Great Ouse Catchment Board, under Section 4 (1) (b) of the Act, making provision for the following matters:—

1. The alteration of the boundaries of the Feldale Internal Drainage District and the Whittlesey and Kingsland Internal Drainage District by the amalgamation with the Feldale Internal Drainage District of a portion of the Whittlesey and Kingsland Internal Drainage District.

2. The reconstitution of the Feldale Internal Drainage Board.

3. Matters supplemental thereto or consequential thereon.

By Part III of the Second Schedule to the said Act, it is provided that if any person aggrieved by an Order desires to question its validity on the ground that it is not within the powers of the Act or that any requirement of the Act has not been complied with, he may, within six weeks after the publication of this notice, make an application for the purpose to the High Court, and if any such application is duly made, the Court, if satisfied that the Order is not within the powers of the Act, or that the interests of the applicant have been substantially prejudiced by any requirements of the Act not having been complied with, may quash the Order either generally or in so far as it affects the applicant.
