At the Court at Buckingham Palace, the 8th day of December, 1950

PRESENT

The KING's Most Excellent Majesty in Council

WHEREAS there was this day read at the Board a Memorial from the Right Honourable the Lords Commissioners of the Admiralty, dated the 3rd day of November, 1950, (C.W. 13596/50) in the words following, viz.:-

"Whereas by Section 3 of the Naval and Marine Pay and Pensions Act, 1865, it is enacted, *inter alia*, that all pay, pensions or other allowances in the nature thereof payable in respect of services in Your Majesty's Naval or Marine Force to a person being or having been an Officer, Seaman or Marine therein, shall be paid in such manner and subject to such restrictions, conditions and provisions as are from time to time directed by Order in Council:

"And whereas by Order in Council dated the 27th day of April, 1948, certain rates of pay and allowances were laid down for Officers of Your Majesty's Naval and Marine Forces:

"And whereas we are of opinion that certain of these rates of pay and allowances require revision:

"And whereas we also consider that a Commissioned Officer on the Royal Naval Branch List on promotion from the lower deck should receive a rate of pay at least equivalent to the total of his rating's emoluments in the nature of pay in issue on the day before promotion:

"We beg leave humbly to recommend that Your Majesty may be graciously pleased, by Your Order in Council, to sanction the proposals contained in the Schedules annexed hereto, with effect from the 1st day of September, 1950, except where otherwise provided, and in substitution for the provisions previously authorised:

"The Lords Commissioners of Your Majesty's Treasury have signified their concurrence in these proposals:

" SCHEDULE I—GENERAL

"1. The rates of full pay and allowance in the following Schedules to apply to Officers of the Royal Navy and Royal Marines, and also in accordance with their several ranks and subject to the regulations governing their service, to Officers of the Royal Naval Reserve and the Royal Naval Volunteer Reserve, while serving or training in H.M. Ships or Establishments or while called out for actual service in war or emergency. The rates prescribed not to apply to Officers serving on T.124 or similar Agreements, nor to Officers appointed for time only or otherwise holding naval rank for purposes of status only. The rates of full pay in Schedule II not to apply to National Service Officers during the first eighteen months of their full-time service including any time as rating. Such Officers to receive the rates of full pay authorised by Schedule II of Order in Council of 27th April, 1948 until they have completed eighteen months full-time service, after which the rates in Schedule II below will apply in their case.

"2. Increments of full pay for Royal Naval Reserve and Royal Naval Volunteer Reserve Officers to continue to depend on mobilised service on naval rates of full pay in the confirmed rank.

" SCHEDULE II—FULL PAY

"1.—(a) *Executive, Air, Engineering, Electrical, Supply and Secretariat, Ordnance, and Special Branches (General List Officers).*
