Borough of Altrincham, Footpath (St. Andrew's Avenue to Bridge Grove) Extinguishment Order, 1950.

NOTICE is hereby given that on the 8th day of January, 1951, the Minister of Town and Country Planning confirmed the above Order.

The effect of the Order is to extinguish the public right of way running in a north easterly direction from St. Andrew's Avenue, Timperley, to Bridge Grove, Timperley.
