

Smirna, put into this Port, and they set Sail this day for London, under Convoy of Her Majesty's Ship the Swan. The sixth there was a very great Storm, and three other homeward-bound Spanish Ships were cast away at Gomally, between this Place and Mountsbay, viz. the *Barkow* Frigate, Captain Hughes Commander, who was drowned, with 45 of his Men, the *Revard*, Captain Bower Commander, who lost 18 Men out of 27, and the *Conrad*, Captain Bourne Commander, who was lost, with all his Crew, except one Man. The seventh was in Her Majesty's Ship the *Swallow*, with several Ships under her Convoy, bound for the North Coast and Ireland.

Hampth, May 23. On the 17th Instant came in here the *John of Amsterdam* from the *Amoy*, with a French Prize of 14 Guns, laden with Fish. Two Dutch Privateers with 7 Guns from *Hampth*, bound to *Holland*, which sailed again this day to the Eastward, with two Dutch Privateers, and three Prizes more, in Company with Her Majesty's Ship the *Exeter*, and about 30 Sail of homeward-bound Merchant Ships and Coasters. The 21st came in Her Majesty's Ship the *Winchester* from the Fleet commanded by Sir George Rooke off *Ushant*, and brought in with her the *Sarah* of London, Daniel Lewis Master, bound home from *Guinea*, which she had retaken. This day came in two Dutch Privateers, and 4 Prizes, 5 of them laden with Salt, and the other in Ballast.

Portsmouth, May 23. Yesterday came to Spithead Her Majesty's Ship the *Leux*, from the Fleet under the Command of Sir George Rooke, and brought in with her a French homeward-bound *East India* Ship, which was taken the 15th by Her Majesty's Ship the *Medway*: This Prize was formerly an English Man of War, called the *Success*, which was taken from us during the last War; she had above 30 Guns and 90 Men on board, and is laden with Mullins and Calicoes, to the value, as is said, of above 100000 l.

Yarmouth, May 24. A Fleet of about 400 Sail of laden Coiliers sailed from hence yesterday, under Convoy of Her Majesty's Ships the *Reverend*, and *Successor* h, most of them bound for the River of *Thames*.

Comst, May 24. Yesterday a *Flushing* Caper brought in here a French Prize, which she took off *Cape La Hague*, laden with Salt and Fruit.

Deal, May 25. Her Majesty's Ship the *Hampshire* came into the *Downs* last night, having under her Convoy the *Bonno* from the *East-Indies*, and the *Merricat*, the *Sea-Horse*, and the *Venezian*, from *Smirna*.

Lichfield, May 24. His Grace the Duke of Ormond, Lord Lieutenant of Ireland, arrived here this evening, having been received in all the Places through which he passed with very great Marks of Respect; At *Coventry* the Mayor and Corporation, with the several Companies, all in their Formalities, met his Grace at the Gates; and here he was met by the Bailiff, Sheriffs and Corporation, at their Bounds, which are two Miles out of Town. His Grace intends to go to-morrow to *Newport*, and to be on *Thursday* at *Chester*, in order to embark there for *Ireland*.

Whitehall, May 24. The Treaty of Alliance between the Emperor, Her Majesty, the King of Portugal, and the States General, which has been so long talked of, was Signed at *Lisbon* the 16th Instant, N. S. and is brought hither by an Express.
