At the Court at Buckingham Palace, the 15th day of March, 1951.

PRESENT,

The KING's Most Excellent Majesty in Council

WHEREAS there was this day read at the Board a Memorial from the Right Honourable the Lords Commissioners of the Admiralty, dated the 7th day of March, 1951 (C.W.16163/50) in the words following, viz.:—

"Whereas by Section 3 of the Naval and Marine Pay and Pensions Act, 1865, it is enacted, *inter alia*, that all pay, pensions or other allowances in the nature thereof payable in respect of services in Your Majesty's Naval or Marine Forces to a person being or having been an Officer, Seaman or Marine therein, shall be paid in such manner and subject to such restrictions, conditions and provisions as are from time to time directed by Order in Council:

"And whereas by Order in Council dated the 27th day of April, 1948, certain rates of pay and allowances were laid down for Officers of Your Majesty's Naval and Marine Forces:

"And whereas we are of opinion that certain of these rates of pay and allowances require revision:

"We beg leave humbly to recommend that Your Majesty may be graciously pleased, by Your Order in Council, to sanction the proposals contained in the Schedules annexed hereto, with effect from the

1st day of September, 1950, except where otherwise provided, and in substitution for the provisions previously authorised:

"The Lords Commissioners of Your Majesty's Treasury have signified their concurrence in these proposals:

" SCHEDULE I—GENERAL.

"1. The rates of full pay and specialist allowances in the following Schedules to apply to Medical and Dental Officers of the Royal Navy, and also in accordance with their several ranks and subject to the regulations governing their service, to Medical and Dental Officers of the Royal Naval Volunteer Reserve, while serving or training in H.M. Ships or Establishments or while called out for actual service in war or emergency. The rates of full pay and Specialist Allowances in the following Schedules not to apply to National Service Officers during the first eighteen months of their full-time service. Such Medical and Dental Officers to receive the rates of full pay and Specialist Allowances authorised by Schedule II and Schedule IV respectively of Order in Council of 27th April, 1948, until they have completed eighteen months full-time service, after which the rates in Schedules II and III below will apply in their case.

"2. Increments of full pay for Medical and Dental Officers of the Royal Naval Volunteer Reserve to continue to depend on mobilised service on naval rates of full pay in the confirmed rank.

" SCHEDULE II—FULL PAY

" 1. Medical Officers

" (a) The following scale to apply to:—

(i) Officers entered into the R.N. or permanent or temporary R.N.V.R., on or after 1st July, 1946.

(ii) Officers holding the substantive or acting rank of Surgeon Captain or above R.N., or Surgeon Commander or above R.N.V.R.
