TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING ACT, 1947.

The Minister of Transport hereby gives notice that he has made an Order under section 49 of the Town and Country Planning Act, 1947, entitled "The Stopping up of Highways (Dorset) (No. 1) Order, 1951" authorising the stopping up of a footpath from Kaye's Lane to Portland Road at Wyke Regis, Weymouth, in the County of Dorset.

Any person aggrieved by the Order and desiring to question the validity thereof, or of any provision contained therein, on the ground that it is not within the powers of the Town and Country Planning Act, 1947, or that any requirement of that Act or of any regulation made thereunder has not been complied with in relation to the Order, may, within six weeks of the 20th day of March, 1951, apply to the High Court for the suspension or quashing of the Order or of any provision contained therein.
