At the Court at Buckingham Palace, the 28th day of April, 1951.

PRESENT,

The KING's Most Excellent Majesty in Council.

WHEREAS the Church Commissioners have duly prepared and laid before His Majesty in Council a Scheme bearing date the 15th day of March, 1951, in the words and figures following, that is to say:—

"We, the Church Commissioners, acting in pursuance of the New Parishes Measure, 1943, have prepared and humbly lay before Your Majesty in Council the following Scheme for constituting a new parish to be taken out of the parishes of Saint Augustine, Wembley Park, and Saint Mary the Virgin, Kenton, in the diocese of London.

"SCHEME.

"Whereas we, the Church Commissioners, are satisfied that the spiritual interests of the area defined in the subjoined Schedule and delineated on the map hereto annexed would be best served by constituting it a new parish:

"And whereas we are satisfied that a suitable endowment therefor will be provided:

"And whereas we have not approved any consecrated church within the area as suitable to be the parish church of the new parish:

"Now, therefore, with the consent of the Right Honourable and Right Reverend William, Bishop of London (in testimony whereof he has set his hand and affixed his episcopal seal to this Scheme), we, the said Church Commissioners, do humbly recommend and propose as follows, that is to say:—

"1. *Constitution.*

"(a) As from the date of the licence thereto of a Minister the area defined in the subjoined Schedule and delineated on the map hereto annexed shall be a separate district for spiritual purposes.

"(b) As from the date of the consecration of a church within the area approved by us, the said Church Commissioners, as suitable to be a parish church, or if the church is consecrated before such approval, the date of the approval, the said area shall become a new parish.

"(c) The name of the district (or parish as the case may be) shall be 'The District (or Parish) of The Ascension, Preston'.

"2. *Archdeaconry and Rural Deanery:*

"The parish shall be in the Archdeaconry of Hampstead and in the rural deanery of Harrow.

"THE SCHEDULE.

"The area comprising:—

"(a) All that part of the parish of Saint Augustine, Wembley Park (coloured pink on the map annexed hereto) which lies to the north of the middle of the Metropolitan Railway Line of the London Transport Executive.

"(b) All that adjoining part of the parish of Saint Mary the Virgin, Kenton (coloured green on the map annexed hereto) which is bounded upon the south and east by the parish of Saint Augustine, Wembley Park, and upon the remaining sides by an imaginary line commencing on the boundary which divides the parish of Saint Augustine, Wembley Park, from the parish of Saint Mary the Virgin, Kenton, at a point in the middle of Woodcock Hill opposite to the middle of the southern end of Manning Gardens, and continuing thence northwards along the middle of Manning Gardens to a point in the middle of Mount Stewart Avenue opposite to the middle of the northern end of Manning Gardens and continuing thence eastwards along the middle of Mount Stewart Avenue to a point in the middle of Trevelyan Crescent opposite to the middle of the eastern end of Mount Stewart Avenue and continuing thence generally north-eastwards along the middle of Trevelyan Crescent to a point in the middle of Shaftesbury Avenue opposite to the middle of the northeastern end of Trevelyan Crescent and continuing thence north-westwards along the middle of Shaftesbury Avenue to a point opposite to the middle of the southwestern end of Westward Way and continuing thence north-eastwards along the middle of Westward Way to a point in the middle of Regal Way opposite to the middle of the north-eastern end of Westward Way and continuing thence northwards along the middle of Regal Way to a point opposite to the middle of the southwestern end of Lindsay Drive and continuing thence north-eastwards along the middle of Lindsay Drive to a point in the middle of Wealdstone Brook opposite to the middle of the northeastern end of Lindsay Drive and continuing thence generally southwards along the middle of Wealdstone Brook to a point opposite to the western end of the wall or fence at the rear of the house and premises known as number 43, Imperial Way, and continuing thence to and along the walls or fences at the rear of the houses and premises on the southwestern side of Imperial Way (thereby crossing Belvedere Way) and continuing thence north-eastwards along the wall or fence which divides the house and premises known as number 1 Imperial Way from the house and premises known as number 122, Preston Hill and in the same straight line to the boundary which divides the parish of Saint Mary the Virgin, Kenton, from the parish of Saint Augustine, Wembley Park."

And whereas the provisions of the New Parishes Measure, 1943, relating to the preparation and submission of this Scheme, have been duly complied with:

And whereas the said Scheme has been approved by His Majesty in Council:

Now, therefore, His Majesty, by and with the advice of, His said Council, is pleased hereby to ratify the said Scheme, and to order and direct that the same and every part thereof shall be effectual in law immediately upon the publication
