The Lords Commissioners of His Majesty's Treasury hereby give notice that They have made an Order under Sections 1 and 19 of the Import Duties Act, 1932, Section 10 (3) of the Finance Act, 1934, and Section 1 of the Import Duties (Emergency Provisions) Act, 1939, viz.:—

The Import Duties (Exemptions) (No. 6) Order, 1951, which exempts from import duty sulphuric acid and oleum.

The Order comes into operation on the 24th May, 1951, and has been published as Statutory Instruments 1951, No. 880.
