ST. ALBANS RURAL DISTRICT COUNCIL.

St. Albans Rural District Council (Colney Heath) Public Path Diversion Order 2/1951.

NOTICE is hereby given that the above Order was made on the 22nd day of May, 1951, and is about to be submitted to the Minister of Local Government and Planning for confirmation.

The order relates to land situate in the Parish of Colney Heath.

The effect of the Order will be to divert the public right of way running from Hatfield-road in a south-easterly direction through land in the ownership of the Franki Compressed Pile Company Limited to a point on the southern boundary of the Company's land west of Butterwick Wood to a line running southwards from Hatfield-road to the east of and immediately adjacent to the western boundary of the Company's land, through and parallel with the southern boundary of the Company's land to the point where the existing right of way meets such boundary.
