Adwyddu, Penrhynddraeth, Path Diversion Order, 1951.

NOTICE is hereby given that the above Order was made on the 24th day of July, 1951, and is about to be submitted to the Minister of Local Government and Planning for confirmation.

The Order relates to land in the Parish of Penrhynddraeth.

The effect of the Order will be to divert in Enclosure No. 145, shown on Merionethshire Ordnance Survey XI-14 the existing public right of way running in a south-westerly direction from the direction of Adwyddu Farm and through the Council's Housing Site to a line running firstly in a westerly direction and thence in a southerly direction and again westwards to join the said existing path.

Chanctonbury (Washington—Glasbys Lane) Diversion Order, 1951.

NOTICE is hereby given that on the 7th day of July, 1951 the Minister of Local Government and Planning confirmed, with modification, the above named Order.

The effect of the Order is to create a public right of way on foot commencing at a point on the northern side of Glasbys Lane approximately 480 feet west of the junction of Glasbys Lane with the London—Worthing road (A.24) and proceeding in a northerly direction along the centre of a cart track forming Ordnance Parcel No. 491 (Ordnance Survey Sheet Sussex (West) LI/5 Edition of 1911) for a distance of approximately 140 feet thence in
