Notice is hereby given in pursuance of Section 85 (3) of the Diseases of Animals Act, 1950, that the Minister of Agriculture and Fisheries has made the following Orders:—

Statutory Instruments 1951 No. 2164

The Foot-and-Mouth Disease (Infected Areas) Special Order No. 42, 1951. (Made 5th December, 1951.)

Amends the Foot-and-Mouth Disease (Infected Areas) Special Order No. 41, 1951, so as to permit the movement of pigs to a slaughterhouse or bacon factory in the parish of Norton in the County of East Riding of Yorkshire.

Statutory Instruments 1951 No. 2165.

The Foot-and-Mouth Disease (Controlled Areas) Special Order No. 10, 1951. (Made 5th December, 1951.)

Excludes the Counties of Nottingham and East Riding of Yorkshire and part of the County of West Riding of Yorkshire from the Foot-and-Mouth Disease Controlled Area declared by the Foot-and-Mouth Disease (Controlled Areas) Special Order No. 3, 1951, and extended by Special Orders Nos. 4, 5 and 9, 1951.
