Speed Limit—London Traffic Area.

TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING ACT, 1947.

TRUNK ROADS ACT, 1946.

SPECIAL ROADS ACT, 1949.

The Minister of Transport hereby gives notice that he has made an Order under subsection 2 of section 1 of the Trunk Roads Act, 1946, as amended by the Special Roads Act, 1949, the effect of which is that a new road which he proposes to construct at Thurmaston and Syston in the County of Leicester will become a trunk road on the date when the Order comes into operation and that that length of the Bath—Cheltenham—Evesham—Coventry—Leicester—Lincoln Trunk Road to be superseded thereby will cease to be a trunk road on the first day of April next after the date on which notice is given by the Minister to the Leicestershire County Council (who will thereafter become the highway authority responsible for that road) that the new road is opened for through traffic.
