Notice is hereby given that the Minister of Transport has made "The London Traffic (Prescribed Routes) (No. 4) Regulations, 1952" (S.I. 1952, No. 289), coming into operation on the 6th day of March, 1952, which prohibits vehicles (a) from making a right-hand turn into Shaftesbury Avenue from Earlham Street, Holborn, and (b) from making a direct crossing from Neal Street to James Street, Holborn, and institutes one-way traffic working in the streets enumerated below as follows:—

1. 2. Streets or Lengths of Street Direction City of Westminster From north-west to south-east. Arne Street Burleigh Street, between its junction with Tavistock Street and its junction with the Strand.

Catherine Street, between its junction with Tavistock Street and its junction with Russell Street. From north-west to south-east. From south-east to north-west. Covent Garden Drury Lane, from its junction with the Aldwych to the City Boundary. In a clockwise direction. From north-west to south-east, except that vehicles may make a direct crossing from Russell Street to Kemble Street and from Kemble Street to Russell Street. From south-west to north-east, except that vehicles may make a direct crossing from Arne Street to Dryden Street may make a direct crossing from Arne Street to Arne Street in a south-easterly direction.
