## LONDON TRAFFIC ACT, 1924.

## LONDON PASSENGER TRANSPORT ACT, 1933.

Notice is hereby given that the Minister of Transport has made "The London Traffic (Prescribed Routes) (No. 4) Regulations, 1952" (S.I. 1952, No. 289), coming into operation on the 6th day of March, 1952, which prohibits vehicles (a) from making a right-hand turn into Shaftesbury Avenue from Earlham Street, Holborn, and (b) from making a direct crossing from Neal Street to James Street, Holborn, and institutes one-way traffic working in the streets enumerated below as follows:—

## SCHEDULE.

Arne Street ... ..	From north-west to south-east.
Burleigh Street, between its junction with Tavistock Street and its junction with the Strand.	From north-west to south-east.
Catherine Street, between its junction with Tavistock Street and its junction with Russell Street.	From south-east to north-west.
Covent Garden ... ..	In a clockwise direction.
Drury Lane, from its junction with the Aldwych to the City Boundary.	From north-west to south-east, except that vehicles may make a direct crossing from Russell Street to Kemble Street and from Kemble Street to Russell Street.
Dryden Street ... ..	From south-west to north-east, except that vehicles may make a direct crossing from Arne Street to Arne Street in a south-easterly direction.
Exeter Street, between its junction with the Strand and its junction with Catherine Street.	From south-east to north-west, continuing at bend from south-west to north-east, except that vehicles may make a direct crossing from Burleigh Street to Burleigh Street in a south-easterly direction and from Wellington Street to Wellington Street in either direction.
Floral Street ... ..	From south-west to north-east, except that vehicles may make a direct crossing from James Street to James Street in a north-westerly direction.
Henrietta Street ... ..	From north-east to south-west.
James Street ... ..	From south-east to north-west.
King Street ... ..	From south-west to north-east.
Langley Street ... ..	From north-west to south-east.
Maiden Lane ... ..	From south-west to north-east.
Mart Street ... ..	From north-west to south-east.
Mercer Street, between its junction with Long Acre and its junction with Shelton Street.	From south-east to north-west.
Neal Street, between its junction with Long Acre and its junction with Shelton Street.	From south-east to north-west.
New Row ... ..	From east to west.
Southampton Street, between its junction with Tavistock Street and its junction with Covent Garden.	From south-east to north-west.
Tavistock Street, between its junction with Southampton Street and its junction with Drury Lane.	From south-west to north-east, except that vehicles may make a direct crossing from Wellington Street to Wellington Street in either direction and from Catherine Street to Catherine Street in a north-westerly direction.

Betterton Street ... ..	From north-east to south-west.
Drury Lane, from its junction with High Holborn to the Borough Boundary.	From north-west to south-east.
Earlham Street, between its junction with Neal Street and its junction with Seven Dials.	From east to west.
Earlham Street between its junction with Seven Dials and its junction with Shaftesbury Avenue.	From east to west.
Mercer Street, between its junction with Shelton Street and its junction with Seven Dials.	From south-east to north-west.
Mercer Street, between its junction with Seven Dials and its junction with Shaftesbury Avenue.	From south-east to north-west.
Museum Street, between its junction with New Oxford Street and its junction with High Holborn.	From north-west to south-east, except that vehicles may make a direct crossing from West Central Street to West Central Street in either direction.
Neal Street, between its junction with Shelton Street and its junction with Shaftesbury Avenue.	From south-east to north-west, except that vehicles may make a direct crossing from Short's Gardens to Short's Gardens in a south-westerly direction.
Parker Street, between its junction with Kingsway and its junction with Newton Street.	From north-east to south-west.
Shelton Street, between its junction with Monmouth Street and its junction with Arne Street.	From south-west to north-east, except that vehicles may make a direct crossing from Mercer Street to Mercer Street in a north-westerly direction and from Neal Street to Neal Street in a north-westerly direction and from Endell Street to Endell Street in either direction.
Shelton Street, between its junction with Drury Lane and its junction with Parker Street.	From south-west to north-east continuing at bend from north-west to south-east.
Short's Gardens, between its junction with Endell Street and its junction with Seven Dials.	From north-east to south-west.
Short's Gardens, between its junction with Endell Street and its junction with Drury Lane.	From south-west to north-east.
Tower Street ... ..	From south-east to north-west.
