TRUNK ROADS ACT, 1946.

SPECIAL ROADS ACT, 1949.

The Minister of Transport hereby gives notice that he has made an Order under subsection 2 of section 1 of the Trunk Roads Act, 1946, as amended by the Special Roads Act, 1949, the effect of which is that on the date when the Order comes into operation, a length of the Neath—Abergavenny road in the County Borough of Merthyr Tydfil will become a trunk road and six new roads which he proposes to construct in the Counties of Glamorgan, Brecon and Monmouth and in the County Borough of Merthyr Tydfil will become trunk roads in substitution for five lengths of the Neath—Abergavenny Trunk Road and a length of the East of Abercynon—East of Dowlais Trunk Road and any length of the said Trunk Roads to be superseded by any one of the new roads will cease to be a trunk road on the first day of April next after the date on which notice is given by the Minister to the appropriate Council (who will become the highway authority responsible for the length) that the relevant new road is opened for through traffic.

DISEASES OF ANIMALS ACT, 1950.

Notice is hereby given in pursuance of Section 85 (3) of the Diseases of Animals Act, 1950, that the Minister of Agriculture and Fisheries has made the following Orders:—

Statutory Instruments 1952 No. 292.

The Foot-and-Mouth Disease (Infected Areas) Special Order No. 20, 1952 (made 14th February, 1952).

Extends the Foot-and-Mouth Disease Infected Area around Seaton, Hull, Yorkshire, described in the Schedule to the Foot-and-Mouth Disease (Infected Areas) Special Order No. 12, 1952, so as to include that part of the County of East Riding of Yorkshire which lies within approximately 5 miles of Thearne, Beverley.

Statutory Instruments 1952 No. 308.

The Foot-and-Mouth Disease (Infected Areas) Special Order No. 21, 1952 (made 15th February, 1952).

1. Contracts, as from 21st February, 1952, the Foot-and-Mouth Disease Infected Area around St. Cross South Elmham, Harleston, Norfolk, described in the Schedule to the Foot-and-Mouth Disease (Infected Areas) Special Order No. 17, 1952, to an area comprising the districts situate within approximately 5 miles of St. Cross South Elmham.

2. Releases such contracted Infected Area from restrictions on 28th February, 1952.
