FOOD AND DRUGS ACT, 1938.

The Borough of Heywood (Food) Order, 1952.

NOTICE is hereby given that the Minister of Health, in pursuance of the powers conferred on him by section 14 of the Food and Drugs Act 1938, has made an Order entitled the Borough of Heywood (Food) Order 1952, declaring section 14 of the Food and Drugs Act 1938 to be in force in the Borough of Heywood.

The said section 14 requires the registration of premises used in connection with the manufacture, sale or storage of ice cream, or the preparation or manufacture of sausages or potted, pressed, pickled or preserved food intended for sale.

BOROUGH OF LEIGH.

FOOD AND DRUGS ACT, 1938.

NOTICE is hereby given that the Minister of Health, upon application being made to him by the Town Council of the Borough of Leigh, has made an Order declaring section 14 of the Food and Drugs Act, 1938, to be in force in the Borough of Leigh.

The Order is cited as the Borough of Leigh (Food) Order, 1952, and will come into operation on the 1st day of April, 1952.

Section 14 of the Food and Drugs Act, 1938, provides that no premises shall be used for:

(a) the sale, or manufacture for the purpose of sale, of ice-cream, or the storage of ice-cream intended for sale; or

(b) the preparation or manufacture of sausages or potted, pressed, pickled or preserved food intended for sale,

unless they are registered for such purpose by the local authority, and a person who uses any premises in contravention of the provisions of the section shall be guilty of an offence under the Act.

The section further provides that in prescribed circumstances the local authority may refuse an application for the registration of premises under the section or cancel the existing registration of premises, and any person aggrieved by such decision may appeal to a Court of Summary Jurisdiction.

BOROUGH OF STRETFORD (FOOD) ORDER 1952.

NOTICE is hereby given that the Minister of Health has made an Order under Section 14 of the Food and Drugs Act 1938 declaring that Section 14 of that Act will come into force in the Borough of Stretford on the 1st April 1952.
