1. Constitution : "(a) As from the date of the licence thereto of a Minister, the area defined in the subjoined Schedule

Minister, the area defined in the subjoined Schedule and delineated on the map hereto annexed shall be a separate district for spiritual purposes. "(b) As from the date of the consecration of a church within the area approved by us, the said Church Commissioners, as suitable to be a parish church, or if the church is consecrated before such approval, the date of the approval, the said area shall become a new parish. "(c) The name of the district (or parish as the case may be) shall be 'The District (or Parish) of Saint Alban, Romford'.

"2. Archdeaconry and Rural Deanery: "The parish shall be in the Archdeaconry of West Ham and in the rural deanery of Chafford, otherwise Romford.

Now, therefore, Her Majesty, by and with the advice of Her said Council, is pleased hereby to ratify the said Scheme, and to order and direct that the same and every part thereof shall be effectual in law immediately upon the publication of this Order in the London Gazette pursuant to the said Measure.

And Her Majesty, by and with the like advice, is pleased hereby to direct that this Order be forthwith registered by the Registrar of the said Diocese of Chelmsford.
