THE LYING IN STATE

On Monday, February 11th, Guards of Honour of the Royal Navy, the Army, and the Royal Air Force were mounted at King's Cross Station and Westminster Hall.

On the arrival of the train at 2.45 the Royal Coffin was removed by an Officer and ten men of the King's Company Grenadier Guards and placed upon a Gun Carriage drawn by the King's Troop, Royal Horse Artillery.

The Imperial State Crown was placed upon the Coffin, which was covered by the Royal Standard.

The Gun Carriage, flanked by the Bearer Party of the Grenadier Guards, was preceded by Mounted Police.

walked immediately behind the Royal Coffin, followed by certain Members of His late Majesty's Household.

Mounted Police closed the Procession.

On arrival at Westminster Hall where members of both Houses of Parliament were present the Coffin was taken from the Gun Carriage by the Bearer Party of the King's Company, Grenadier Guards, and was received by the Archbishop of York, the Lord Great Chamberlain, the Earl Marshal, and the Minister of Works, and carried to the Catafalque prepared for it in the following order:—



When the Royal Coffin had been placed upon the Catafalque HER MAJESTY THE QUEEN, Her Majesty the Queen Mother, and the other Royal Mourners stood at the head of the Coffin.

The Gentlemen at Arms and the Yeomen of the Guard took their customary places on either side, the Lord Great Chamberlain and the Earl Marshal took their stand at the foot of the Coffin.

The Service was conducted by the Archbishop of York, who stood by the head of the Coffin, facing the Royal Mourners.

After the Service HER MAJESTY THE QUEEN, Her Majesty the Queen Mother and the other Members of the Royal Family were conducted by the Archbishop of York, the Lord Great Chamberlain, the Earl Marshal and the Officers of Arms to the entrance of Westminster Hall.

THE FUNERAL

On Friday, February 15th, Guards of Honour were mounted at Westminster Hall and Paddington Railway Station.

At 9.30 o'clock in the morning the Royal Coffin, covered by the Royal Standard, and with the Crown, Sceptre and Orb laid thereon, was removed from Westminster Hall by a Bearer Party of the King's Company, Grenadier Guards and placed upon a Gun Carriage drawn by Naval Ratings.

Detachment of The Life Guards.

On arrival at the Chapel, the Representative Officers of Foreign Services, the General Officer Commanding the Household Brigade and his Staff, the Aides de Camp, and the other Naval, Military, and Air Force representatives, ranged themselves on either side of the steps leading to the West Door of the Chapel, and proceeded into the Chapel at the end of the Procession. The Pursuivants and Heralds, and the Kings of Arms (except Garter), when the Procession reached the Choir, took their places on either side of the Entrance. Black Rod and Garter passed into the Choir.

At the West Door of the Chapel the Royal Remains were received by:—

The Archbishop of Canterbury,

The Archbishop of York,

The Bishop of Winchester, Prelate of the Order of the Garter,

The Dean of Windsor, Register of the Order of the Garter,

with the Canons, Minor Canons, Lay Clerks and Choristers of St. George's Chapel.

The Procession moved up the Nave, headed by the Choir and Clergy, and the opening Sentences of the Burial Service were chanted by the Choir.

The Earl Marshal, The Lord Chamberlain and the Lord Steward walked immediately in front of the Coffin, which was followed by The Queen, the other Members of the Royal Family, the Royal Representatives, and the remainder of the Procession.

HER MAJESTY THE QUEEN stood at the Head of the Coffin.

The Lord Chamberlain took his place at the Foot of the Coffin.

The Lesson was read by The Bishop of Winchester. The Hymn "The Strife is o'er" was then sung and the Sentence "I heard a Voice from Heaven" was sung by the Choir.

The Prayers were said by The Archbishop of Canterbury and The Archbishop of York, and the Dean of Windsor.

Garter King of Arms pronounced the Styles of His late Majesty;

"Thus it hath pleased Almighty God to take out of this transitory life unto His Divine Mercy the late Most High, Most Mighty, and Most Excellent Monarch, George the Sixth, by the Grace of God, of Great Britain, Ireland, and the British Dominions beyond the Seas, King, Defender of the Faith, and Sovereign of the Most Noble Order of the Garter.

"Let us humbly beseech Almighty God to bless with long life, health, and honour, and all worldly happiness, the Most High, Most Mighty, and Most Excellent Monarch, our Sovereign Lady, Elizabeth the Second, now, by the Grace of God, of Great Britain, Ireland, and the British Dominions beyond the Seas, Queen, Defender of the Faith, and Sovereign of the Most Noble Order of the Garter."

"GOD SAVE THE QUEEN."

The Choir sang "God be in my head and in my understanding" and The Archbishop of Canterbury then pronounced the Benediction.

The King's Company Colour of the Grenadier Guards was handed to The Queen by Colonel G. C. Gordon Lennox, D.S.O., Lieutenant-Colonel Commanding Grenadier Guards and placed on the Coffin by Her Majesty.

H.E. Monsieur Queuille (member of the French Delegation), H.R.H. Princess Yukanthor (representing the King of Cambodia), and Monsieur Ourot Souvannavong (representing the King of Laos), were present amongst the distinguished guests in the Chapel, as was also Madame Ofelia Segreda de Wright (representing the Republic of Costa Rica): the Principality of Liechtenstein was represented by the Swiss representative.

His Majesty's Body Guard of the Honourable Corps of Gentlemen at Arms were on duty in the Nave of the Chapel.

Minute Guns were fired in the Long Walk at Windsor while the Procession moved from Windsor Station to St. George's Chapel.
